10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

11 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
12 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3436.6 of Title 36, unless there
13 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

14 An insurer, as defined in Section 3634.2 of Title 36 of the
15 Oklahoma Statutes, shall provide direct payment or reimbursement to
16 a pharmacist licensed in this state for providing a health care
17 service to an individual if:

18 1. The pharmacist provided any health care service he or she is
19 licensed to perform in the practice of pharmacy, as defined in
20 Section 353.1 of Title 59 of the Oklahoma Statutes, in this state;
21 and

22 2. The health benefit policy, contract or agreement of the
23 individual provides for payment or reimbursement of the service.

24 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
