Adopted all Senate amendments to HB 1794. Removed one of the criteria in distinguishing entities that provide care or treatment to persons with Alzheimer's dementia or other forms of dementia.

Transferred the authority to promulgate rules for the Alzheimer's Dementia and Other Forms of Dementia Special Care Disclosure Act from the State Department of Health to the State Commissioner of Health with input from the Alzheimer-Dementia Disclosure Act Advisory Council.

Modified the definition of "Dementia" to match the Centers for Disease Control (CDC) definition.
