Section 1 subsection B authorizes municipalities, subject to the Municipal Campaign Finance and Financial Disclosure Act, to contract with interlocal entities and when applicable to follow the provisions of their own comprehensive code of campaign finance and personal disclosure ordinances.

Section 2 paragraph 1 authorizes municipalities, exempt from the Municipal Finance and Financial Disclosure Act, to enact a comprehensive code of campaign finance and personal disclosure ordinances including policies and provisions for the administration and enforcement of the ordinances. It also allows for municipalities to provide for hearings, enforcement and civil fines not to exceed \$500.

Section 2 paragraph 2 authorizes municipalities to contract with interlocal entities for the administration and enforcement of their code of campaign finances and personal financial disclosure ordinances.
