General Subject Matter: Medical marijuana

General Description of <u>Major Differences</u> between the current report and the version last seen and voted on in the House and the sections in which such differences are located:

√ Changes from engrossed House measure which were made in the Senate and contained in conference committee report/substitute (applies *only* to House measures):

Medical marijuana business licenses will not be issued until all necessary inspections and reviews have been completed.

√ Changes made in conference:

The CCR creates a temporary medical marijuana business license. All entities seeking licensure must first apply for a temporary license, which will be valid for 180 days and for which an application fee of \$1,000 will be assessed. The temporary license is conditional and does not authorize the licensee to sell, grow, process, or transport marijuana.

Those applying for a temporary license or applying to renew a license must submit certain information to OMMA, including but not limited to financial information, a diagram of the proposed premises, and evidence of insurance. Grow license applicants must also provide identification of all power sources, coordinates for water sources, and a proposed cultivation plan.
