21	Section 2-309C. A. A dispenser of a Schedule II, III, IV or V
22	controlled dangerous substance dispensed pursuant to a valid
23	prescription shall transmit to a central repository designated by
24	the Oklahoma State Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control

1 using the American Society for Automation in Pharmacy's (ASAP) Telecommunications Format for Controlled Substances version 2 designated in rules by the Oklahoma State Bureau of Narcotics and 3 4 Dangerous Drugs Control, the following information for each 5 dispensation: 6 Recipient's and recipient's agent's name; 1. 7 2. Recipient's and recipient's agent's address; 3. Recipient's and recipient's agent's date of birth; 8 9 4. Recipient's and recipient's agent's identification number; National Drug Code number of the substance dispensed; 10 5. 11 6. Date of the dispensation; Quantity of the substance dispensed; 12 7. 13 8. Prescriber's United States Drug Enforcement Agency 14 registration number; Dispenser's registration number; and 15 9. 16 10. Other information as required by administrative rule. 17 Β. The information required by this section shall be 18 transmitted: 19 1. In a format or other media designated acceptable by the 20 Oklahoma State Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control; and 21 2. Within twenty-four (24) hours of the time that the substance 22 is dispensed. Beginning January 1, 2012, all information shall be 23 submitted on a real-time log. 24

When a prescription is written or dispensed to a resident of 2 a nursing home or a person who is under the care of a hospice program licensed pursuant to the provisions of the Oklahoma Hospice 3 Licensing Act who does not have an identification card issued by the 4 5 state or another form of a recipient identification number pursuant to Section 2-309B of this title, a Social Security number may be 6 7 used for the purpose of complying with the reporting requirements provided for in this section. 8

9 D. When a prescription is written or dispensed to a person
10 whose state-issued identification card has been expired for no more
11 than one (1) year, and who does not possess another form of a
12 recipient identification number pursuant to Section 2-309B of this
13 title, a Social Security number may be used for the purpose of
14 complying with the reporting requirements provided for in this
15 section.

<u>E.</u> Willful failure to transmit accurate information as required by this section shall be a misdemeanor punishable, upon conviction, by not more than one (1) year in the county jail, or by a fine of not more than One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), or by both such imprisonment and fine, or administrative action may be taken pursuant to Section 2-304 of this title.

 $E. \underline{F.}$ The Director of the Bureau shall have the authority to allow paper submissions on a form designated by the Oklahoma State
