PROPOSED COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to state government; amending 74 O.S. 2011, Section 94, as amended by Section 794, Chapter 304, O.S.L. 2012 (74 O.S. Supp. 2020, Section 94), which relates to the designation of quarters and space to state departments; providing limitations to certain relocations beyond a certain radius of distance; providing exception; providing for codification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2011, Section 94, as amended by Section 794, Chapter 304, O.S.L. 2012 (74 O.S. Supp. 2020, Section 94), is amended to read as follows:

Section 94. A. Except as otherwise provided by law, the Office of Management and Enterprise Services shall have ~~full and complete~~ authority to designate quarters for every department of state government, and to determine what space shall be allotted; provided that no department of state government shall be designated quarters or allotted space that results in the relocation of such department's employees, or relocation of the performance of duties

1 imposed upon such department by law, to a location beyond a radius
2 of ten (10) miles from where such employees and performance of such
3 duties were located as of July 1, 2020, unless such relocation is
4 directly authorized by an act of the Legislature.

5 B. The Office may lease adequate space in state buildings and
6 facilities to private vendors for the location of automatic teller
7 machines as determined necessary or appropriate by the Director of
8 the Office. The Office is hereby authorized to fix the monthly
9 amount to be paid by such vendors, which shall be deposited in the
10 General Revenue Fund.

11 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
12 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3320 of Title 74, unless there
13 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

14 No agency, board, commission, authority, bureau, office or other
15 department of state government shall relocate such entity's
16 employees, or relocate the performance of duties imposed upon such
17 entity by law, to a location beyond a radius of ten (10) miles from
18 where such employees and performance of such duties were located as
19 of July 1, 2020, unless such relocation is directly authorized by an
20 act of the Legislature.

21 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
22 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
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1 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
2 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
