PROPOSED COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to motor vehicles; allowing motor license agents to purchase cameras from the Department of Public Safety; authorizing the Department to promulgate certain rules; requiring motor license agents to obtain Internet services of certain adequacy; repealing 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1140.1, as amended by Section 1, Chapter 175, O.S.L. 2017 (47 O.S. Supp. 2020, Section 1140.1), which relates to cameras furnished to appointed motor license agents; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1140.2 of Title 47, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. The Department of Public Safety may require motor license agents to purchase cameras from the Department for the motor license agent's use in conducting business. The Department is authorized to

1 promulgate any rules necessary to effectuate the provisions of this
2 subsection.

3 B. If motor license agents purchase a camera from the
4 Department, the motor license agents shall be responsible for
5 obtaining, at their own expense, Internet services that operate at
6 adequate transmission speeds to allow the agents to effectively
7 transact business and transmit data to and from the agency.

8 SECTION 2. REPEALER 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1140.1, as
9 amended by Section 1, Chapter 175, O.S.L. 2017 (47 O.S. Supp. 2020,
10 Section 1140.1), is hereby repealed.

11 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
