PROPOSED COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to the Oklahoma Department of
Agriculture, Food, and Forestry; requiring that
portions of certain appropriated funds be used for
certain purposes; providing procedures; providing
lapse dates; and requiring and prohibiting certain
budget procedures.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma
Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry in Enrolled House Bill
No. 2900 of the 1st Session of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature, the
sum of Three Million Dollars (\$3,000,000.00) shall, under the
direction of the Commissioner of Agriculture, be allocated to the
Oklahoma State University College of Veterinary Medicine.

1 SECTION 2. From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma
2 Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry in Enrolled House Bill
3 No. 2900 of the 1st Session of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature, the
4 sum of Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000.00) shall, under the
5 direction of the Commissioner of Agriculture, be allocated to the
6 extension offices that are affiliated with the Oklahoma State
7 University Agricultural Extension Service.

8 SECTION 3. From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma
9 Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry in Enrolled House Bill
10 No. 2900 of the 1st Session of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature, the
11 sum of One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) shall, under the
12 direction of the Commissioner of Agriculture, be allocated to the
13 research centers that are affiliated with the Oklahoma State
14 University Agriculture Experiment Stations.

15 SECTION 4. From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma
16 Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry in Enrolled House Bill
17 No. 2900 of the 1st Session of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature, the
18 sum of One Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$150,000.00) shall, under
19 the direction of the Commissioner of Agriculture, be allocated for
20 facility improvements needed for cattle stock shows.

21 SECTION 5. From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma
22 Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry in Enrolled House Bill
23 No. 2900 of the 1st Session of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature, the
24 sum of Three Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$300,000.00) shall, under the

1 direction of the Commission of Agriculture, be allocated to hire
2 additional full-time meat inspectors.

3 SECTION 6. Appropriations made by Enrolled House Bill No. 2900
4 of the 1st Session of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature, not including
5 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for
6 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2022 (hereafter FY-22) or may be
7 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2023 (hereafter FY-23).
8 Funds budgeted for FY-22 may be encumbered only through June 30,
9 2022, and must be expended by November 15, 2022. Any funds
10 remaining after November 15, 2022, and not budgeted for FY-23, shall
11 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal
12 year. Funds budgeted for FY-23 may be encumbered only through June
13 30, 2023. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2023, shall lapse
14 to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.
15 These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years
16 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-22, and not required to pay
17 obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-23, after
18 the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared
19 and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds
20 from the FY-22 budget work program and after such revision has been
21 approved by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services.
