19	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified						
20	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 510A of Title 57, unless there						
21	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:						
22	A. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving						
23	fund for the Department of Corrections to be designated the						
24	"Department of Corrections Offender Management System Revolving						

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    Fund". The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal
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    year limitations, and shall consist of all monies directed for
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    deposit by law. All monies accruing to the credit of said fund are

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    fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer
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    against claims filed as prescribed by law with the Director of the

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    of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
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    declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
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    be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
