PROPOSED SUBCOMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to schools; creating the Oklahoma Education Commission; setting expiration date of Commission; providing for membership; requiring organizational meeting by certain date; directing certain members to serve as chair and vice-chair; requiring approval of quorum for final action; specifying quorum requirement; providing for frequency of meetings; prescribing duties of Commission; subjecting Commission to certain acts; prohibiting compensation or travel reimbursement for members; providing for staff support; requiring submission of certain report by certain date; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 14-201 of Title 70, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. There is hereby created until November 1, 2027, the Oklahoma Education Commission.

B. The Commission shall consist of seventeen (17) members to be appointed as follows:

- 1        1. A member of the Oklahoma House of Representatives shall be  
2 appointed by the Speaker of the Oklahoma House of Representatives;
- 3        2. A member of the Oklahoma State Senate shall be appointed by  
4 the President Pro Tempore of the Oklahoma State Senate;
- 5        3. The Director of the Department of Corrections, or his or her  
6 designee;
- 7        4. The Director of the Oklahoma Department of Libraries, or his  
8 or her designee;
- 9        5. The Executive Director of the Oklahoma Educational  
10 Television Authority, or his or her designee;
- 11       6. Four members with expertise in online and educational  
12 innovation shall be appointed by the Chancellor of Higher Education,  
13 one of whom shall be a representative of the Oklahoma State Regents  
14 for Higher Education, one of whom shall be a representative of a  
15 research institution within The Oklahoma State System of Higher  
16 Education, one of whom shall be a representative of regional  
17 institution within The Oklahoma State System of Higher Education,  
18 and one of whom shall be a representative of a community college  
19 within The Oklahoma State System of Higher Education;
- 20       7. Four members with expertise in effective approaches to  
21 classroom instruction and learning or educational innovation shall  
22 be appointed by the Superintendent of Public Instruction, one of  
23 whom shall represent the State Department of Education, one of whom  
24 shall be a school district administrator, one of whom shall be a

1 certified classroom teacher, and one of whom shall be a high school  
2 student; and

3 8. Four members with expertise in effective approaches to  
4 career and technology education instruction and learning or  
5 educational innovation shall be appointed by the Director of the  
6 Oklahoma Department of Career and Technology Education, one of whom  
7 shall represent the Oklahoma Department of Career and Technology  
8 Education, one of whom shall be an administrator of a state  
9 technology center school or college, one of whom shall be a  
10 certified teacher at a state technology center school or college,  
11 and one of whom shall be a student enrolled at a state technology  
12 center school or college.

13 C. The Commission shall hold an organizational meeting not  
14 later than ninety (90) days after the effective date of this act.  
15 The member of the Oklahoma House of Representatives shall serve as  
16 chair of the Commission and the member of the Oklahoma State Senate  
17 shall serve as vice-chair. A quorum of the membership of the  
18 Commission shall be required to approve any final action of the  
19 Commission. For purposes of this section, nine members shall  
20 constitute a quorum.

21 D. The Commission may meet as often as required to perform the  
22 duties imposed upon it, but shall meet at least quarterly.

23 E. The Commission shall engage multiple stakeholders in  
24 research, evaluation, and information sharing to conduct a study on

1 how to improve the quality of instruction and learning through  
2 distance and remote modalities. Topic areas of the study shall  
3 include, but not be limited to:

- 4 1. Support infrastructure;
- 5 2. Open education resources;
- 6 3. Compliance with the federal Americans with Disabilities Act;
- 7 4. Professional development; and
- 8 5. Modality research.

9 F. The Commission shall be subject to the Oklahoma Open Meeting  
10 Act and the Oklahoma Open Records Act.

11 G. Members of the Commission shall not receive compensation or  
12 travel reimbursement.

13 H. The Oklahoma House of Representatives shall provide staff  
14 and administrative support for the Commission.

15 I. The Commission shall submit a report of its findings and  
16 recommendations no later than November 1, 2027, to the Governor, the  
17 President Pro Tempore of the Oklahoma State Senate, and the Speaker  
18 of the Oklahoma House of Representatives.

19 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
