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13	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
14	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-1951.2 of Title 63, unless
16	there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
17	A. As used in this section:
18	1. "Personal services" means any service which puts a nursing
19	home resident in a vulnerable position. Personal services include,
20	but are not limited to, the following services:
21	a. administering certain medications,
22	b. bathing the resident,
23	c. changing dressings,
24	d. changing bedpans, and

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e. dressing the resident; and

2. "Private setting" means a setting in which a resident would
 3 be placed in a vulnerable position, such as a private room or
 4 bathroom.

B. When a resident is in a private setting in a nursing home or skilled nursing home, or assisted living facility receiving personal services, there must be at least two individuals in the room with the resident, unless the resident requests to have only one person in the room.

C. Any nursing home or skilled nursing home which violates this
 act may face monetary penalties and a loss of state certification.

D. Failure to comply with this act shall be considered to place the resident in immediate jeopardy as outlined in the Nursing Home Care Act.

15 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
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
