17	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 29 O.S. 2021, Section 7-304, is

19	Section 7-304. A. Except as otherwise provided by law, no
20	person may enter upon any state or federal wildlife refuge or
21	Wildlife Management Area with dog, gun or bow.
22	B. Exceptions to the above provisions are when the Oklahoma
23	<u>Wildlife Conservation</u> Commission and/or the <u>Oklahoma</u> Tourism and
24	Recreation Commission may by resolution permit:

The holding of field trials by duly authorized sportsmen's
 clubs; or

3 2. Such hunting, killing or trapping of wildlife from such
4 refuge or Wildlife Management Area; provided, however, that Lake
5 Murray State Park shall not be utilized for killing or trapping of
6 natural wildlife and shall remain a wildlife preserve.

7 C. Any person convicted of violating provisions of this section shall be punished by a fine of not less than Twenty-five Dollars 8 9 (\$25.00) nor more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) One Thousand 10 Dollars (\$1,000.00), or by imprisonment in the county jail for not 11 less than ten (10) days nor more than thirty (30) days, or by both 12 such fine and imprisonment for the first violation. A subsequent 13 violation may result in the suspension of privileges to hunt, kill, 14 or trap within such refuge or Wildlife Management Area or a 15 revocation of the person's hunting license by the Commission. 16 D. Persons entering any refuge or Wildlife Management Area, 17 except for Three Rivers Wildlife Management Area and Honobia Creek 18 Wildlife Management Area, to hunt, kill, or trap any wildlife shall 19 notify the Department of Wildlife Conservation, before entering any 20 refuge or Wildlife Management Area, except for Three Rivers Wildlife 21 Management Area and Honobia Creek Wildlife Management Area, by 22 electronic notification through the Department's application. 23 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2022.
