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14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
15	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2021, Section 11-502, is
16	amended to read as follows:
17	Section 11-502. (a) When traffic-control signals are not in
18	place or not in operation, the driver of a vehicle shall yield the
19	right-of-way, slowing down or stopping if need be to so yield, to a
20	pedestrian crossing the roadway within a crosswalk when the
21	pedestrian is upon the half of the roadway upon which the vehicle is
22	traveling, or when the pedestrian is approaching so closely from the
23	opposite half of the roadway as to be in danger. <u>This applies to</u>
24	both marked and unmarked crosswalks.

(b) No pedestrian shall suddenly leave a curb or other place of
 safety and walk or run into the path of a vehicle which is so close
 that it is impossible for the driver to yield.

4 (c) Paragraph (a) shall not apply under the conditions stated in 5 Section 11-503(b).

(d) Whenever any vehicle is stopped at a marked crosswalk or at
any unmarked crosswalk at an intersection to permit a pedestrian to
cross the roadway, the driver of any other vehicle approaching from
the rear shall not overtake and pass such stopped vehicle.

10SECTION 2.AMENDATORY47 O.S. 2021, Section 11-503, is11amended to read as follows:

Section 11-503. (a) Every pedestrian crossing a roadway at any point other than within a marked crosswalk or within an unmarked crosswalk at an intersection shall yield the right-of-way to all vehicles upon the roadway.

16 (b) Any pedestrian crossing a roadway at a point where a 17 pedestrian tunnel or overhead pedestrian crossing has been provided 18 shall yield the right-of-way to all vehicles upon the roadway. 19 (c) Between adjacent intersections at which traffic-control 20 signals are in operation pedestrians shall not cross at any place 21 except in a marked crosswalk No persons shall purposefully or 22 negligently walk into traffic or into a public street in a manner 23 that puts themselves in danger of bodily harm or causes a motor 24 vehicle crash.

1SECTION 3.AMENDATORY47 O.S. 2021, Section 11-506, is2amended to read as follows:

3 Section 11-506. (a) Where sidewalks are provided, <u>and in usable</u>
4 <u>and accessible condition in accordance with the Americans with</u>
5 <u>Disabilities Act</u>, it shall be unlawful for any pedestrian to walk
6 along and upon an adjacent roadway.

7 (b) Where sidewalks are not provided, any pedestrian walking 8 along and upon a highway shall, when practicable, walk only on the 9 left side of the roadway or its shoulder facing traffic which may 10 approach from the opposite direction and shall yield to approaching 11 vehicles.

(c) It shall be unlawful for any person to enter upon any portion of a bridge for the purpose of diving or jumping therefrom into a lake, river or stream for recreation, and it shall be unlawful for a pedestrian to use a bridge where sidewalks are not provided for the purpose of standing or sightseeing.

SECTION 4. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
