The section of State Highway 56 beginning at the intersection of Dripping Springs Road extending easterly to the intersection of Madison Avenue on the west side of the city of Okmulgee in Okmulgee County shall be designated as the "Senator Roger Ballenger Memorial The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the highway. SECTION 2. The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the bridge. SECTION 5. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.368 of Title 69, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: The section of U.S. Highway 59 in Stilwell beginning on the north side of the State Highway 100 intersection extending north to the intersection of State Highway 51 East in Adair County shall be designated as the "Vernus W. Bales Memorial Highway". Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the highway. SECTION 6.
