8 PROPOSED COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

9 An Act relating to schools; creating a maximum
10 compensation schedule for school superintendents;
11 providing for increased compensation based on the
12 average daily membership of the school district;
13 directing the State Board of Education to promulgate
14 rules; providing for codification; providing an
15 effective date; and declaring an emergency.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
18 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 18-114.15 of Title 70, unless
19 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

20 A. Beginning with the 2022-2023 school year, a school district
21 board of education shall not enter into a new contract or renew a
22 contract with a superintendent after July 1, 2022, that exceeds the
23 maximum compensation amounts provided for in the following schedule:

24 1. For the superintendent of a district or districts with an
average daily membership (ADM) of one hundred fifty (150) or fewer

1 students, the salary for the lowest-salaried teacher in the district
2 with an education degree and amount of experience that is equal to
3 the degree and experience held by the superintendent multiplied by
4 one and three-tenths (1.3);

5 2. For the superintendent of a district or districts with an
6 ADM of two hundred fifty (250) or fewer students but more than one
7 hundred fifty (150) students, the salary for the lowest-salaried
8 teacher in the district with an education degree and amount of
9 experience that is equal to the degree and experience held by the
10 superintendent multiplied by one and four-tenths (1.4);

11 3. For the superintendent of a district or districts with an
12 ADM of five hundred (500) or fewer students but more than two
13 hundred fifty (250) students, the salary for the lowest-salaried
14 teacher in the district with an education degree and amount of
15 experience that is equal to the degree and experience held by the
16 superintendent multiplied by one and five-tenths (1.5);

17 4. For the superintendent of a district or districts with an
18 ADM of one thousand (1,000) or fewer students but more than five
19 hundred (500) students, the salary for the lowest-salaried teacher
20 in the district with an education degree and amount of experience
21 that is equal to the degree and experience held by the
22 superintendent multiplied by one and six-tenths (1.6);

23 5. For the superintendent of a district or districts with an
24 ADM of two thousand five hundred (2,500) or fewer students but more

1 than one thousand (1,000) students, the salary for the lowest-
2 salaried teacher in the district with an education degree and amount
3 of experience that is equal to the degree and experience held by the
4 superintendent multiplied by one and eight-tenths (1.8);

5 6. For the superintendent of a district or districts with an
6 ADM of five thousand (5,000) or fewer students but more than two
7 thousand five hundred (2,500) students, the salary for the lowest-
8 salaried teacher in the district with an education degree and amount
9 of experience that is equal to the degree and experience held by the
10 superintendent multiplied by two (2.0);

11 7. For the superintendent of a district or districts with an
12 ADM of ten thousand (10,000) or fewer students but more than five
13 thousand (5,000) students, the salary for the lowest-salaried
14 teacher in the district with an education degree and amount of
15 experience that is equal to the degree and experience held by the
16 superintendent multiplied by two and two-tenths (2.2);

17 8. For the superintendent of a district or districts with an
18 ADM of fifteen thousand (15,000) or fewer students but more than ten
19 thousand (10,000) students, the salary for the lowest-salaried
20 teacher in the district with an education degree and amount of
21 experience that is equal to the degree and experience held by the
22 superintendent multiplied by two and four-tenths (2.4);

23 9. For the superintendent of a district or districts with an
24 ADM of twenty thousand (20,000) or fewer students but more than

1 fifteen thousand (15,000) students, the salary for the lowest-
2 salaried teacher in the district with an education degree and amount
3 of experience that is equal to the degree and experience held by the
4 superintendent multiplied by two and six-tenths (2.6);

5 10. For the superintendent of a district or districts with an
6 ADM of thirty thousand (30,000) or fewer students but more than
7 twenty thousand (20,000) students, the salary for the lowest-
8 salaried teacher in the district with an education degree and amount
9 of experience that is equal to the degree and experience held by the
10 superintendent multiplied by two and eight-tenths (2.8); and

11 11. For the superintendent of a district or districts with an
12 ADM of more than thirty thousand (30,000) students, the salary for
13 the lowest-salaried teacher in the district with an education degree
14 and amount of experience that is equal to the degree and experience
15 held by the superintendent multiplied by three and one-tenths (3.1).

16 B. The State Board of Education shall promulgate rules
17 necessary to implement the provisions of this section.

18 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2022.

19 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
20 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby

1 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
2 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
