22	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
23	A. Upon the effective date of this act, all medical marijuana
24	flower, trim, shake, kief, or other flower-based product not defined

1 as a concentrate shall be sold by licensed medical marijuana 2 processors and licensed medical marijuana commercial growers to 3 licensed medical marijuana dispensaries only in pre-packaged form in 4 package sizes weighing from not less than one-eighth (1/8) of one 5 (1) ounce to not more than one (1) ounce.

B. The packaging of medical marijuana flower may contain nonopaque materials provided that it meets all other packaging and
labeling requirements for edible medical marijuana products sold in
the State of Oklahoma and is placed in an opaque container before
leaving a licensed medical marijuana dispensary.

11 C. The display and smelling of medical marijuana shall be 12 allowed pursuant to current Oklahoma law; provided, however, deli-13 style sales shall no longer be allowed.

14 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation 15 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby 16 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and 17 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
