15	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified		
16	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-242.5 of Title 63, unless		
17	there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:		
18	A. For the purposes of the Maternal Mortality Review Committee,		
19	hospitals and licensed birth centers must make a reasonable and good		
20	faith effort to report all deaths that occur during pregnancy or		
21	within one (1) year of termination of pregnancy to the local coroner		
22	or medical examiner for consideration of an autopsy.		
23	B. These deaths must be reported within seventy-two (72) hours		
24	after the death occurs

C. Medical examiners to whom the death was reported shall conduct a death investigation, with autopsy strongly recommended but not required. D.
