21	Section 2. The first power reserved by the people is the
22	initiative, and the government shall not accept petitions for
23	changes to state laws unless proposed by petition by eight per
24	centum percent (8%) of the legal voters shall have the right to

1 propose any legislative measure, and the government shall not accept 2 petitions for changes to the Constitution unless proposed by petition by fifteen per centum percent (15%) of the legal voters 3 shall have the right to propose amendments to the Constitution by 4 5 petition of each congressional district of this state, and every such petition shall include the full text of the measure so 6 7 proposed. The second power is the referendum, and it may be ordered (except as to laws necessary for the immediate preservation of the 8 9 public peace, health, or safety), either by petition signed by five 10 per centum percent (5%) of the legal voters of each congressional district of this state or by the Legislature as other bills are 11 12 enacted. The ratio and per centum of legal voters hereinbefore 13 stated shall be based upon the total number of votes cast at the 14 last general election for the Office of Governor. 15 SECTION 2. The Ballot Title for the proposed Constitutional amendment as set forth in SECTION 1 of this resolution shall be in 16 17 the following form: 18 BALLOT TITLE Legislative Referendum No. ____ State Question No. ____ 19 THE GIST OF THE PROPOSITION IS AS FOLLOWS: 20 21 This measure amends the Oklahoma Constitution. The amendment 22 restricts government from accepting petitions to modify the 23 Oklahoma Constitution by changing from statewide to each 24 congressional district of the state.
