PROPOSED COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

A Joint Resolution directing the Secretary of State to refer to the people for their approval or rejection a proposed amendment to Section 1 of Article III of the Oklahoma Constitution; clarifying certain voting requirement; providing ballot title; and directing filing.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND THE SENATE OF THE  
2ND SESSION OF THE 58TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

SECTION 1. The Secretary of State shall refer to the people for their approval or rejection, as and in the manner provided by law, the following proposed amendment to Section 1 of Article III of the Oklahoma Constitution to read as follows:

Section 1. ~~Subject to such exceptions as the Legislature may prescribe, all~~ Only citizens of the United States, over the age of eighteen (18) years, who are bona fide residents of this state, are qualified electors of this state, who upon providing a valid state or federally issued identification, may cast a single vote, by

1 secret ballot, which shall solely be used to determine the results  
2 of any election required by state or federal law.

3 SECTION 2. The Ballot Title for the proposed Constitutional  
4 amendment as set forth in SECTION 1 of this resolution shall be in  
5 the following form:

8 THE GIST OF THE PROPOSITION IS AS FOLLOWS:

9 This measure amends Section 1 of Article 3 of the Oklahoma  
10 Constitution. It clarifies that only citizens of the United  
11 States with a valid identification are qualified to vote in this  
12 state.

13 SHALL THE PROPOSAL BE APPROVED?
