17	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
18	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
19	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1104.33 of Title 47, unless
20	there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
21	A. Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) of the fee authorized by Section
22	1135.5 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes for the Diabetes
23	Awareness license plates shall be deposited to the Diabetes

Awareness License Plate Revolving Fund created in subsection B of
 this section.

There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving 3 Β. fund for the State Department of Health to be designated the 4 5 "Diabetes Awareness License Plate Revolving Fund". The fund shall consist of all monies received pursuant to subsection A of this 6 section. All monies accruing to the credit of the fund are hereby 7 appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the State 8 9 Department of Health for grants to Diabetes Solutions of Oklahoma to 10 raise awareness and provide resources, as well as promote acceptance and inclusion for people with diabetes. Expenditures from the fund 11 12 shall be made upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer against 13 claims filed as prescribed by law with the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services for approval and payment. 14

15 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2021, Section 1135.2, as 16 last amended by Section 4, Chapter 543, O.S.L. 2021, is amended to 17 read as follows:

Section 1135.2 A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby authorized to design and issue appropriate official special license plates to persons in recognition of their service or awards as provided by this section.

22 Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other 23 person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of 24 ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used

on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been
 registered for the current year.

Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax 3 Commission or a motor license agent. The Tax Commission shall 4 5 annually notify by mail all persons issued special license plates. The notice shall contain all necessary information and shall contain 6 instructions for the renewal procedure upon presentation to a motor 7 license agent or the Tax Commission. The license plates shall be 8 9 issued on a staggered system except for legislative plates and amateur radio operator license plates. 10

The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a 11 12 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept applications for special license plates authorized under this 13 The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's section. 14 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount 15 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary 16 17 information directly into such system and generate a receipt accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents 18 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for 19 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for 20 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the 21 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund. 22

B. The special license plates provided by this section are asfollows:

1 1. Prisoner of War License Plates - such plates shall be 2 designed for honorably discharged or present members of the United States Armed Forces and civilians who were former prisoners of war 3 held by a foreign country and who can provide proper certification 4 5 of that status. Such persons may apply for a prisoner of war license plate for no more than two vehicles with each vehicle having 6 a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The surviving 7 spouse of any deceased former prisoner of war, if the spouse has not 8 9 since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is terminated by 10 death, divorce, or annulment, may apply for a prisoner of war license plate for one vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one 11 12 (1) ton or less. The fee provided by this section for the special 13 license plate authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to all other registration fees provided by law, except the registration 14 fees levied by Section 1132 of this title; 15

National Guard License Plates - such plates shall be
 designed for active or retired members of the Oklahoma National
 Guard. Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide
 proof of eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be
 required to provide proof of eligibility annually;

Air National Guard License Plates - such plates shall be
 designed for active or retired members of the Oklahoma Air National
 Guard. Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide

1 proof of eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be 2 required to provide proof of eligibility annually;

4. United States Armed Forces License Plates - such plates 3 shall be designed for active, retired, former or reserve members of 4 5 the United States Armed Forces, and shall identify which branch of service, and carry the emblem and name of either the Army, Navy, Air 6 Force, Marines or Coast Guard, according to the branch of service to 7 which the member belongs or did belong. Former members who have 8 9 been dishonorably discharged shall not be eligible for such plates. Persons applying for such license plate must show proof of present 10 or past military service by presenting a valid Uniformed Services 11 Identity Card or the United States Department of Defense Form 12 (DD)214. Retired or former members who are eligible for such plates 13 shall provide proof of eligibility upon initial application, but 14 shall not be required to provide proof of eligibility annually; 15

5. Congressional Medal of Honor Recipient License Plates - such plates shall be designed for any resident of this state who has been awarded the Congressional Medal of Honor. Such persons may apply for a Congressional Medal of Honor recipient license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.
There shall be no registration fee for the issuance of this plate;

6. Missing In Action License Plates - such plates shall be
designed to honor members of the United States Armed Forces who are
missing in action. The spouse of such missing person, if the spouse

1 has not since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is 2 terminated by death, divorce, or annulment, and each parent of the missing person may apply for a missing in action license plate upon 3 presenting proper certification that the person is missing in action 4 5 and that the person making the application is the qualifying spouse or the parent of the missing person. The qualifying spouse and each 6 parent of the missing person may each apply for the missing in 7 action license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity 8 9 of one (1) ton or less;

7. Purple Heart Recipient License Plates - such plates shall be 10 designed for any resident of this state presenting proper 11 12 certification from the United States Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United States certifying that such 13 resident has been awarded the Purple Heart military decoration. 14 Such persons may apply for a Purple Heart recipient license plate 15 for vehicles having a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or 16 less. The surviving spouse of any deceased veteran who has been 17 awarded the Purple Heart military decoration, if such spouse has not 18 since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage has been terminated 19 by death, divorce or annulment, may apply for such plate for one 20 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The 21 license plate created by this paragraph shall be exempt from the fee 22 provided by this section for special license plates; 23

Such person may apply for an Iwo Jima license plate for each 3 4 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. 5 Such license plate shall have the legend "Oklahoma OK" and shall contain three letters and three numbers. Between the letters and 6 numbers shall be a logo of the flag-raising at Iwo Jima. Below the 7 letters, logo and numbers, the plate shall contain the words "FEB." 8 9 at the left, "Iwo Jima" in the center and "1945" at the right. Such plates shall not be subject to the design requirements of any other 10 license plates prescribed by law other than the space for the 11 12 placement of the yearly decals for each succeeding year of registration after the initial issue; 13

14 10. D-Day Survivor License Plates - such plates shall be
15 designed for any resident of this state who can be verified by the
16 United States Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of
17 the United States as being:

a. a member of the United States Armed Forces on June 6,

1944,

b. a participant in the Allied invasion of the coast of
Normandy on June 6, 1944; provided, if such
participation cannot be verified by the United States
Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of
the United States, the Tax Commission may, in its

discretion, accept evidence of such participation from the person applying for the license plate, and c. a recipient of an honorable discharge from the United States Armed Forces.

5 Such person may apply for a D-Day Survivor license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less; 6 11. Killed in Action License Plates - such plates shall be 7 designed to honor members of the United States Armed Forces who were 8 9 killed in action. The spouse of the deceased person, if the spouse has not remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is terminated by 10 death, divorce, or annulment, may apply for a killed in action 11 license plate upon presenting proper certification that the person 12 was killed in action and that the person making the application is 13 the qualifying spouse of the deceased person. The qualifying spouse 14 may apply for a killed in action license plate for no more than two 15 vehicles with each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) 16 ton or less. The fee provided by this section for the special 17 license plate authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to 18 all other registration fees provided by law, except the registration 19 fees levied by Section 1132 of this title. Beginning on the 20 effective date of this section of this act November 1, 2021, the 21 killed in action license plate shall be designed to honor members of 22

23 the United States Armed Forces who were killed in action while 24 engaged in combat with a hostile force. The parents, siblings,

1 half-siblings, grandparents or spouse of the deceased person, if the spouse has not remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is 2 terminated by death, divorce or annulment, may apply for a killed in 3 action license plate upon presenting proper certification that the 4 5 person was killed in action and that the person making the application is the qualifying spouse or family member of the 6 deceased person. The qualifying spouse or family member may apply 7 for a killed in action license plate for no more than two vehicles 8 9 with each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or The license plate shall have a white background and the 10 less. legend "Killed in Action" and shall contain any combination of 11 numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven in black, as for 12 personalized license plates. To the left of the numbers and letters 13 shall be the Battlefield Cross in gold. The killed in action 14 license plate shall be exempt from any minimum issuance criteria 15 related to license plate applications; 16

12. Gold Star Families License Plates - such plates shall be 17 designed to honor members of the United States Armed Forces who were 18 killed while on active duty. The parents, siblings, half-siblings 19 or grandparents of the deceased person may apply for a gold star 20 license plate upon presenting proper certification that the person 21 was killed while on active duty and that the person making the 22 application is the parent, sibling, half-sibling or grandparent of 23 the deceased person. The family member may apply for a gold star 24

families license plate for no more than two vehicles with each vehicle having a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The fee provided by this section for the special license plate authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to all other registration fees provided by law, except the registration fees levied by Section 1132 of this title;

7 13. Military Decoration License Plates - such plates shall be 8 designed for any resident of this state who has been awarded the 9 Distinguished Service Medal, the Distinguished Service Cross, the 10 Distinguished Flying Cross, the Bronze Star military decoration or 11 the Silver Star military decoration. Such persons may apply for a 12 military decoration license plate for each vehicle with a rated 13 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

14 14. Vietnam Veteran License Plates - such plates shall be 15 designed for honorably discharged or present members of the United 16 States Armed Forces who served in the Vietnam Conflict. Such 17 persons may apply for a Vietnam veteran license plate for each 18 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

19 15. Police Officer License Plates - such plates shall be 20 designed for any currently employed, reserve or retired municipal 21 police officer or full-time, reserve or retired university police 22 officer certified by the Council on Law Enforcement Education and 23 Training or common education police officer certified by the Council 24 on Law Enforcement Education and Training. Police officers may

1 apply for police officer license plates for vehicles with a rated 2 capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a motorcycle upon proof of employment by or retirement from a municipal, university or common 3 education police department by either an identification card or 4 5 letter from the chief of the police department or the Oklahoma Police Pension and Retirement Board. Retirees who are eligible for 6 such plates shall provide proof of eligibility upon initial 7 application but shall not be required to provide proof of 8 9 eligibility annually. The license plates shall be designed in consultation with municipal police departments of this state; 10 provided, the license plate for motorcycles may be of similar design 11 12 to the license plate for motor vehicles or may be a new design in 13 order to meet space requirements for a motorcycle license plate; World War II Veteran License Plates - such plates shall be 16. 14 designed to honor honorably discharged former members of the United 15 States Armed Forces who are residents of this state and who can be 16 verified by the Oklahoma Military Department of the State of 17 Oklahoma, the Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of 18 the United States as having served on federal active duty anytime 19 during the period from September 16, 1940, to December 7, 1945. 20 The former members may apply for a World War II Veteran license plate 21 for vehicles with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. 22 The license plate shall have the legend "Oklahoma" and shall 23

24 contain, in the center of the plate, either the Thunderbird Insignia

1 of the 45th Infantry Division in the prescribed red and gold coloring or the emblem of the Army, Navy, U.S. Army Air Corps, 2 Marines or Coast Guard according to the branch of service to which 3 the member belonged. For the purpose of license plate 4 5 identification, the plate shall contain four digits, two digits at the left and two digits at the right of the insignia or emblem. 6 Centered on the bottom of the license plate shall be the words 7 "WORLD WAR II"; 8

9 17. Korean War Veteran License Plates - such plates shall be designed to honor honorably discharged former members of the United 10 States Armed Forces who are residents of this state and who can be 11 12 verified by the Oklahoma Military Department of the State of Oklahoma, the Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of 13 the United States as having served on federal active duty anytime 14 during the period from June 27, 1950, to January 31, 1955, both 15 dates inclusive. The former members may apply for a Korean War 16 Veteran license plate for vehicles with a rated carrying capacity of 17 one (1) ton or less. 18

19 The license plate shall have the legend "OKLAHOMA" and shall 20 contain, in the center of the plate, either the Thunderbird Insignia 21 of the 45th Infantry Division in the prescribed red and gold 22 coloring or the emblem of the Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines or 23 Coast Guard according to the branch of service to which the member 24 belonged. For the purpose of license plate identification, the

1 plate shall contain four digits, two digits at the left and two 2 digits at the right of the insignia or emblem. Centered on the 3 bottom of the license plate shall be the word "KOREA";

4 18. Municipal Official License Plates - such plates shall be
5 designed for persons elected to a municipal office in this state and
6 shall designate the name of the municipality and the district or
7 ward in which the municipal official serves. The plates shall only
8 be produced upon application;

9 19. Red Cross Volunteer License Plates - such plates shall be 10 designed to honor American Red Cross volunteers and staff who are residents of this state. Such persons must present an 11 12 identification card issued by the American Red Cross and bearing a photograph of the person. The license plate shall be designed with 13 the assistance of the American Red Cross and shall have the legend 14 "Oklahoma OK!" in the color Pantone 186C Red. Below the legend the 15 symbol of the American Red Cross and no more than three letters and 16 three numbers shall be in the color Pantone 186C Red. Below the 17 symbol and letters and numbers shall be the words "American Red 18 Cross" in black. The plates shall not be subject to the design 19 requirements of any other license plates prescribed by law other 20 than the space for the placement of the yearly decals for each 21 succeeding year of registration after the initial issue; 22 Desert Storm License Plates - such plates shall be designed 20. 23 and issued to any honorably discharged or present member of the 24

United States Armed Forces who served in the Persian Gulf Crisis and
 the Desert Storm operation. Such persons may apply for a Desert
 Storm license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity
 of one (1) ton or less;

5 21. Military Reserve Unit License Plates - such plates shall be 6 designed and issued to any honorably discharged or present member of 7 a reserve unit of the United States Armed Forces. Such persons may 8 apply for a Military Reserve Unit license plate for each vehicle 9 with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

10 22. Oklahoma City Bombing Victims and Survivors License Plates
11 - such plates shall be designed and issued to any victim or survivor
12 of the bombing attack on the Alfred P. Murrah Federal Building in
13 downtown Oklahoma City on April 19, 1995;

14 23. Civil Air Patrol License Plates - such plates shall be 15 designed and issued to any person who is a member of the Civil Air 16 Patrol. Such persons may apply for a Civil Air Patrol license plate 17 for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or 18 less upon proof of membership in the Civil Air Patrol. The license 19 plate shall be designed in consultation with the Civil Air Patrol;

20 24. Ninety-Nines License Plates - such plates shall be designed 21 and issued to members of the Ninety-Nines. Persons applying for 22 such license plate must show proof of membership in the Ninety-23 Nines. The license plates shall be designed in consultation with 24 the Ninety-Nines;

1 25. Combat Infantryman Badge License Plates - such plates shall 2 be designed to honor recipients of the Combat Infantryman Badge. The plate shall have the legend "Oklahoma OK". Below the legend 3 shall be the Combat Infantryman Badge and three numbers. Below the 4 5 badge and the numbers shall be the words "Combat Infantryman Badge". Such persons may apply for a Combat Infantryman Badge license plate 6 for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or 7 less; 8

9 26. Somalia Combat Veterans License Plates - such plates shall
10 be designed and issued to any honorably discharged or present member
11 of the United States Armed Forces who saw combat in the United
12 Nations relief effort. Such persons may apply for a Somalia Combat
13 Veteran license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying
14 capacity of one (1) ton or less;

15 27. Police Chaplain License Plates - such plates shall be 16 designed and issued to members of the International Conference of 17 Police Chaplains (ICPC) who have completed the ICPC requirements for 18 basic certification as a police chaplain. The license plates shall 19 be designed in consultation with the ICPC;

20 28. Joint Service Commendation Medal License Plates - such 21 plates shall be designed and issued to any resident of this state 22 who has been awarded the Joint Service Commendation Medal by the 23 United States Secretary of Defense;

Merchant Marine License Plates - such plates shall be 2 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission by the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs, and issued to any 3 person who during combat was a member of the Merchant Marines as 4 5 certified by the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs. Such license plate may be issued for each vehicle with a rated carrying 6 capacity of one (1) ton or less; 7

8 30. Legislative License Plates - such plates shall be designed 9 for persons elected to the Oklahoma Legislature and shall designate 10 the house of the Legislature in which the legislator serves and the 11 district number;

12 31. Disabled Veterans License Plates - such plates shall be 13 designed for persons presenting proper certification from the United States Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the 14 United States certifying such veteran has a service-connected 15 disability rating of fifty percent (50%) or more, regardless which 16 17 agency pays the disability benefits, or that such veteran has been awarded a vehicle by the United States government or receives a 18 grant from the United States Department of Veterans Affairs for the 19 purchase of an automobile due to a service-connected disability 20 rating or due to the loss of use of a limb or an eye. Such persons 21 may apply to the Tax Commission for a disabled veterans license 22 plate or to a motor license agent for a regular license plate for no 23 more than two vehicles with each vehicle having a rated carrying 24

1 capacity of one (1) ton or less. The surviving spouse of any 2 deceased disabled veteran, if the spouse has not since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is terminated by death, divorce, or 3 annulment, or a surviving spouse in receipt of Dependency and 4 5 Indemnity Compensation from the United States Department of Veterans Affairs, may apply for a disabled veterans license plate for one 6 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. 7 The fee provided by this section for the special license plate 8 9 authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to all other registration fees provided by law, except the registration fees 10 levied by Section 1132 of this title. The total expense of this 11 12 license plate shall not exceed Five Dollars (\$5.00).

If the person qualifies for a disabled veterans license plate 13 and is also eligible for a physically disabled placard under the 14 provisions of Section 15-112 of this title, the person shall be 15 eligible to receive a disabled veterans license plate that also 16 17 displays the international accessibility symbol, which is a stylized human figure in a wheelchair. Upon the death of the disabled 18 veteran with a disabled veterans license plate with the 19 international accessibility symbol, the plate shall be returned to 20 the Tax Commission; 21

32. United States Air Force Association License Plates - such
plates shall be designed for members of the United States Air Force
Association. Persons applying for such license plate must show

1 proof of membership in the Association. The license plates shall be 2 designed in consultation with the Association;

Oklahoma Military Academy Alumni License Plates - such 3 33. plates shall be designed and issued to any resident of this state 4 5 who is an alumnus of the Oklahoma Military Academy. Such persons may apply for an Oklahoma Military Academy Alumnus license plate for 6 each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. 7 The license plates shall be designed in consultation with the 8 9 Oklahoma Military Academy and shall contain the shield of the 10 Academy;

Amateur Radio Operator License Plates - such plates shall 11 34. 12 be designed and issued to any person, holding a valid operator's license, technician class or better, issued by the Federal 13 Communications Commission, and who is also the owner of a motor 14 vehicle currently registered in Oklahoma, in which has been 15 installed amateur mobile transmitting and receiving equipment. 16 Eligible persons shall be entitled to two special vehicle 17 identification plates as herein provided. Application for such 18 identification plates shall be on a form prescribed by the Tax 19 Commission and the plates issued to such applicant shall have 20 stamped thereon the word "Oklahoma" and bear the official call 21 letters of the radio station assigned by the Federal Communications 22 Commission to the individual amateur operator thereof. All 23 applications for such plates must be made to the Tax Commission on 24

1 or before the first day of October of any year for such plates for 2 the following calendar year and must be accompanied by the fee required in this section together with a certificate, or such other 3 evidence as the Tax Commission may require, of proof that applicant 4 5 has a valid technician class or better amateur operator's license and proof of applicant's ownership of a vehicle in which radio 6 receiving and transmitting equipment is installed. Applicants shall 7 only be entitled to one set of special identification plates in any 8 9 one (1) year, and such calendar year shall be stamped thereon. The right to such special identification plates herein provided for 10 shall continue until the amateur radio operator's license of the 11 person to whom such plates are issued expires or is revoked; 12

13 35. American Legion License Plates - such plates shall be 14 designed for members of the American Legion. Persons applying for 15 such license plate must show proof of membership. The license 16 plates shall be designed in consultation with the American Legion of 17 Oklahoma;

36. Deputy Sheriff License Plates - such plates shall be designed for any currently employed or retired county sheriff or deputy sheriff.
