1 "SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2021, Section 1-103, is  
2 amended to read as follows:

3 Section 1-103. Authorized emergency vehicles - Equipment.

4 A. When equipped as prescribed in subsection B of this section:

5 1. Vehicles of fire departments;

6 2. Ambulances or vehicles specified pursuant to subsection B of  
7 Section 1-2512 of Title 63 of the Oklahoma Statutes of licensed  
8 ambulance service providers;

9 3. State vehicles of law enforcement agencies;

10 4. County vehicles of sheriffs and full-time commissioned  
11 deputies and vehicles designated by the sheriff for support of the  
12 sheriff's office including privately owned vehicles driven by the  
13 sheriff and full-time, part-time and reserve commissioned deputies;  
14 provided the audible sirens and flashing red lights equipped on such  
15 privately owned vehicles are used only in a law enforcement capacity  
16 and in the course of duty;

17 5. Municipal vehicles of police departments;

18 6. Vehicles owned and operated by the United States Marshals  
19 Service or the Federal Bureau of Investigation;

20 7. Vehicles of Oklahoma National Guard units designated by the  
21 Adjutant General for support to civil authorities; ~~or~~

22 8. Vehicles owned and operated by any local organization for  
23 emergency management as defined by Section 683.3 of Title 63 of the  
24 Oklahoma Statutes; or

1        9. Vehicles owned and operated by a company or its agents that  
2 hold a contract with a government entity in this state to perform  
3 cleanup services that result from motor vehicle accidents; provided,  
4 the audible sirens and flashing red lights equipped on such  
5 privately owned vehicles shall be used only when responding to, but  
6 not upon the return from, an authorized motor vehicle accident or  
7 cleanup request,  
8 are authorized emergency vehicles.

9        B. All vehicles prescribed in subsection A of this section  
10 shall be equipped with sirens capable of giving audible signals as  
11 required by the provisions of Section 12-218 of this title and  
12 flashing red lights as authorized by the provisions of Section 12-  
13 218 of this title."
