11	An Act relating to the Oklahoma Firefighters Pension and Retirement System; amending 11 O.S. 2021, Section 29-102, which relates to fire chief duties; allowing municipalities under certain population to hire certain retired members for certain purposes; requiring that certain contributions be made; providing that no additional service credit shall be accrued; prohibiting certain members from collecting certain benefits; prohibiting certain members from being reemployed in certain municipalities; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.				
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19	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:				
20	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 11 O.S. 2021, Section 29-102, is				
21	amended to read as follows:				
22	Section 29-102. All cities having a paid fire department				
23	shall have one full-time fire chief who shall supervise and				
24	administer the fire department in accordance with the policies and				

procedures prescribed by the governing body or by the city manager.

The fire department shall be under the direction and control of the fire chief who shall not serve as fire chief and also as police chief, city manager, mayor or any other position that impairs the ability to perform the duties of a fire chief. The fire chief, whether permanent or interim, of any paid municipal fire department shall have had at least three (3) years' actual experience as a paid fire fighter firefighter before assuming the position of fire chief.

It shall be the duty of the fire chief to file the appropriate

It shall be the duty of the fire chief to file the appropriate activity report forms with the Office of the State Fire Marshal in Oklahoma City on an annual basis. The activity report forms shall be designed by the State Fire Marshal and shall include, but not be limited to, the amount of property and vehicle fire loss, types of fires, inspections and investigations. The report shall include notification of all fire-related civilian deaths and injuries in the respective jurisdiction and of fire fighter firefighter deaths in the line of duty and of fire fighter firefighter injuries in the line of duty requiring the services of a hospital or physician or both.

B. Notwithstanding the requirements of subsections C and H of

Section 49-106.1 of this title to terminate employment with all

participating municipalities as a firefighter, a person receiving an

accrued retirement benefit pursuant to Section 49-106 of this title

may serve as the fire chief of a paid fire department in a

- 1 municipality with a population of twenty thousand (20,000) or less, 2 according to the latest Federal Decennial Census, provided such person meets the qualifications to serve as a paid fire chief, 3 4 including but not limited to the provisions of subsection A of this 5 section. Such paid fire chief and participating municipality shall 6 pay contributions to the Oklahoma Firefighters Pension and 7 Retirement System, pursuant to Section 49-122 of this title, to the extent such fire chief does not have thirty (30) years of credited 8 9 service. No additional credited service will be accrued during 10 which such retired firefighter serves as fire chief of a
 - C. Fire chiefs serving pursuant to subsection B of this section shall not receive a disability pension provided for in Section 49109 of this title, nor shall they be eligible for such disability benefits arising during the period of service described in subsection B of this section.
 - D. A person serving in the capacity of fire chief as of the date such person retires from the System shall not be permitted to become reemployed in the capacity of fire chief by such municipality after the date of the member's retirement.
- 21 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2022.
