10	An Act relating to the Oklahoma Juvenile Code;
11	amending Section 3, Chapter 337, O.S.L. 2017 (10A O.S. Supp. 2020, Section 2-7-620), which relates to
12	juvenile centers; requiring the Office of Juvenile Affairs to provide certain report; authorizing the
13	Office of Juvenile Affairs to enter into certain contracts; updating statutory reference; providing an
14	effective date; and declaring an emergency.

16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
17	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 3, Chapter 337, O.S.L.
18	2017 (10A O.S. Supp. 2020, Section 2-7-620), is amended to read as
19	follows:
20	Section 2-7-620. A. Concurrent with the Office of Juvenile
21	Affairs (OJA) campus consolidation process as contemplated by this
22	act Section 2-7-618 et seq. of this title, OJA is directed to
23	develop, in collaboration with other executive branch agencies and
24	such other entities as OJA deems necessary in furtherance of the

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requirements of this act Section 2-7-618 of this title, plans for the repurposing of the Southwest Oklahoma Juvenile Center and the Oklahoma Juvenile Center for Girls campuses. The agency shall provide a report to the Governor, the Speaker of the Oklahoma House of Representatives and the President Pro Tempore of the Oklahoma State Senate on recommendations for future use of those facilities not later than March 31, 2018, or one hundred eighty (180) days from such date if the provisions of this act Section 2-7-618 et seq. of

this title become effective as law later than July 1, 2017.

- B. No later than October 1, 2021, the OJA shall provide a report to the Governor, the President Pro Tempore of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives on the feasibility of entering into a contract for or operating group homes of any level at the Southwest Oklahoma Juvenile Center campus located in Manitou, Oklahoma.
- C. OJA may enter into a contract with any other state agency to allow for the placement of children or young adults in the custody of a state agency to reside and participate in any identified OJA-contracted or -operated program or facility.
- D. OJA may enter into a contract with any tribal nation or agency or department of the federal government, in consultation with and approval by the Governor and the Attorney General of this state, to allow for the placement of children and young adults in the custody of the tribal nation or an agency or department of the

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    federal government to reside and participate in any identified OJA-
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    contracted or -operated program or facility.
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        SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2021.
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        SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
    of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
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    declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
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    be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
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
