9	An Act relating to cities and towns; authorizing municipalities to publish certain information on
10	website maintained by or on behalf of the municipality; providing for display of certain
11	information on website of newspaper; prohibiting invalidation of certain actions or proceedings due to
12	power interruptions or certain technical failures; providing for codification; and providing an
13	effective date.
14	
15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
16	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
17	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-111 of Title 11, unless there
18	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
19	A. In addition to any provision of law requiring a city or town
20	to publish a notice in a newspaper, the city or town may make the
21	same required information available on a website maintained by or on
22	behalf of the city or town for a time period equal to the periods of
23	time during which the information is required to be contained in a
24	newspaper publication. A city or town may allow the information to

be available on the website for a longer period and shall maintain
records as prescribed by law.

If any provision of law requires a city or town to publish a 3 Β. 4 notice in a daily newspaper and such newspaper is published for 5 fewer than five (5) days in the time period prior to the action or proceeding for which the publication is required, the newspaper may 6 satisfy the requirement by a combination of hard copy publication 7 and publishing of the same required notice information as contained 8 9 in the hard copy publication in a digital electronic edition of the newspaper distributed to subscribers of the hard copy publication. 10 No power interruption or hardware or software failure related to the 11 12 digital electronic edition shall be a basis to invalidate the action 13 or proceeding for which the notice is required to be published in the digital electronic edition. 14 SECTION 2.
