8	An Act relating to oil and gas; amending 52 O.S. 2011, Section 288.5A, as amended by Section 2,
9	Chapter 199, O.S.L. 2013 (52 O.S. Supp. 2020, Section 288.5A), which relates to the Committee for
10	Sustaining Oklahoma's Energy Resources; renaming the Sustaining Oklahoma's Energy Resources Committee as
11	the Legacy Oil and Gas Well Innovation Committee; removing Committee from direction and supervision of
12	Oklahoma Energy Resources Board; deleting certain references; modifying membership requirements for new
13	members; specifying composition of committee membership; construing provisions; conforming
14	language; updating references; amending Section 1, Chapter 199, O.S.L. 2013 (52 O.S. Supp. 2020, Section
15	288.5C), which relates to the elimination of the Commission on Marginally Producing Oil and Gas Wells;
16	removing requirement for certain advice and consent; amending 52 O.S. 2011, Section 288.5B, as last
17	amended by Section 3, Chapter 199, O.S.L. 2013 (52 O.S. Supp. 2020, Section 288.5B), which relates to
18	the Oklahoma Energy Education and Marketing Act; updating certain committee name; renaming fund; and
19	providing an effective date.
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22	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
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SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 52 O.S. 2011, Section 288.5A, as
 amended by Section 2, Chapter 199, O.S.L. 2013 (52 O.S. Supp. 2020,
 Section 288.5A), is amended to read as follows:

Section 288.5A. A. There is hereby created the Committee for 4 5 Sustaining Oklahoma's Energy Resources, after the effective date of this act to be known as the Legacy Oil and Gas Well Innovation 6 7 Committee, which shall be under the direction and supervision of the Oklahoma Energy Resources Board and shall be operate for the purpose 8 9 of encouraging new processes or technological advancements to 10 sustain the oil and natural gas industry in the future for the benefit of the citizens of this state and for advancing activities 11 12 to support marginally producing oil and gas wells.

1. The Committee for Sustaining Oklahoma's Energy Resources 13 Β. shall be made up of not less than twelve but not more than eighteen 14 The Oklahoma Energy Resources Board shall select one 15 members. member of the Board to serve as the chair of the Committee. Except 16 as otherwise provided, members of the Committee shall be appointed 17 by the chair of the Committee and approved by a majority of the 18 Board. 19

20 2. The Secretary of Energy or a designee shall serve as a
 21 member of the Committee for Sustaining Oklahoma's Energy Resources.
 22 The Secretary of Energy shall select one member of the Committee who
 23 shall currently be serving on the Oklahoma Energy Initiative Board

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1 on behalf of the University of Oklahoma, Oklahoma State University, 2 the University of Tulsa or Oklahoma City University. 3 3. Of the remaining members of the Committee for Sustaining Oklahoma's Energy Resources at least: 4 5 a. four members shall be independent oil and gas operators, of which at least one shall be from each of 6 7 the four Corporation Commission regulatory districts as they existed on January 1, 2013, and each shall 8 9 have operations in the district they represent, b. one member shall be an independent oil and gas 10 11 operator from Osage County and shall have operations 12 in Osage County, one member shall be an independent oil and gas 13 с. operator selected from a list of operators submitted 14 15 by the Oklahoma Independent Petroleum Association, one member shall be an oil and gas operator selected 16 d. from a list of operators submitted by the Mid-17 Continent Oil and Gas Association, 18 one member shall be an Oklahoma oil and gas royalty 19 e. owner selected from a list of names submitted by the 20 Oklahoma Mineral Owners Association, and 21 f. one member shall be an Oklahoma oil and gas royalty 22 owner selected from a list of names submitted by the 23 24

1	Oklahoma affiliate of the National Association of
2	Royalty Owners.
3	4. C. 1. Beginning on the effective date of this act, the
4	Committee shall be composed of not less than twelve but not more
5	than eighteen members. The Committee shall select one member to
6	serve as the chair of the Committee. Except as otherwise provided,
7	members of the Committee shall be appointed by the chair of the
8	<u>Committee.</u>
9	The Secretary of Energy or a designee shall serve as a member of
10	the Legacy Oil and Gas Well Innovation Committee. The Secretary of
11	Energy shall select one member of the Committee who shall currently
12	be serving on the Oklahoma Energy Initiative Board on behalf of the
13	University of Oklahoma, Oklahoma State University, the University of
14	<u>Tulsa or Oklahoma City University.</u>
15	2. Of the remaining members of the Legacy Oil and Gas Well
16	Innovation Committee at least:
17	a. eight members shall be marginal oil and gas operators,
18	of which at least one shall be from each of the four
19	Corporation Commission regulatory districts as they
20	existed on January 1, 2013, and each shall have
21	operations in the district they represent,
22	b. one member shall be a marginal oil and gas operator
23	from Osage County and shall have operations in Osage
24	County,

1	c. one member shall be a marginal oil and gas operator
2	selected from a list of operators submitted by the
3	Oklahoma Energy Producers Alliance,
4	d. one member shall be a marginal oil and gas well
5	operator selected from a list of operators submitted
6	by the Petroleum Alliance of Oklahoma,
7	e. one member shall be an Oklahoma oil and gas royalty
8	owner selected from a list of names submitted by the
9	Oklahoma Mineral Owners Association, and
10	f. one member shall be an Oklahoma oil and gas royalty
11	owner selected from a list of names submitted by the
12	Oklahoma affiliate of the National Association of
13	Royalty Owners.
14	Nothing in this section shall be construed to prevent a member
15	of the Board serving under the provisions of subsection B of this
16	section from completing his or her term, or from serving on the
17	committee again following the expiration of his or her term under
18	subsection B of this section.
19	D. With the exception of the Secretary of Energy or the
20	designee of the Secretary, Committee members shall serve for three-
21	year terms and may be removed from the Committee by a majority vote
22	of the Committee with or without cause. The Oklahoma Energy
23	Resources Board Committee may establish any additional
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24 qualifications, requirements or conditions it deems appropriate for

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1 members of the Committee which are consistent with the provisions of 2 this section. The chair of the Committee, with the approval of the 3 Board, shall strive to select representatives of all facets of the oil and natural gas industry, and the University of Oklahoma, 4 5 Oklahoma State University, the University of Tulsa, and Oklahoma City University, in addition to any other interested higher 6 7 education institutions and governmental entities charged with duties and authority over relevant areas. 8

9 5. E. No member of the Committee shall receive a salary for
10 duties performed as a member of the Committee; however, members may
11 be eligible to receive reimbursement for necessary and actual travel
12 expenses as provided for in the State Travel Reimbursement Act if
13 approved by the Oklahoma Energy Resources Board.

14 6. F. Members appointed to serve on the Committee shall be
15 eligible to serve on any other state board or commission if the
16 member is otherwise qualified to hold such appointed office,
17 notwithstanding the provisions of Section 6 of Title 51 of the
18 Oklahoma Statutes.

C. <u>G.</u> The Committee for Sustaining Oklahoma's Energy Resources
 is authorized to accept appropriations, donations, grants,
 <u>assessments</u>, contributions and gifts from any public or private
 source for the purpose of implementing the provisions of this act
 <u>Section 288.1 et seq. of this title</u>. The Committee shall deposit

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such funds in the revolving fund created in Section 288.5B of this
 title.

D. H. The Committee for Sustaining Oklahoma's Energy Resources,
with the advice and consent of the Oklahoma Energy Resources Board,
is authorized to promulgate rules as necessary to implement the
provisions of this act the Oklahoma Energy Education and Marketing
Act.

8 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY Section 1, Chapter 199, O.S.L. 9 2013 (52 O.S. Supp. 2020, Section 288.5C), is amended to read as 10 follows:

Section 288.5C. A. Effective July 1, 2013, all duties, assets and obligations of the Commission on Marginally Producing Oil and Gas Wells created pursuant to Section 700 of Title 52 of the Oklahoma Statutes <u>this title</u> shall be transferred to the authority of the <u>Committee for Sustaining Oklahoma's Energy Resources Legacy</u> <u>Oil and Gas Well Innovation Committee</u> created pursuant to Section 288.5A of Title 52 of the Oklahoma Statutes <u>this title</u>.

B. Effective July 1, 2013, the terms of the members of the
Commission on Marginally Producing Oil and Gas Wells appointed
pursuant to the provisions of Section 700 of Title 52 of the
Oklahoma Statutes this title shall be terminated.

C. Effective July 1, 2013, all unclassified full-timeequivalent, part-time, and temporary employees of the Commission on
Marginally Producing Oil and Gas Wells shall be terminated.

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Employees shall be paid for any accrued annual leave and may be
 eligible for other benefits as provided by law.

D. Activities and functions previously performed by the 3 Commission on Marginally Producing Oil and Gas Wells shall be under 4 5 the responsibility of the Committee for Sustaining Oklahoma's Energy Resources Legacy Oil and Gas Well Innovation Committee or a 6 successor committee as provided by law. The Committee may organize 7 itself, create subcommittees or adopt procedures as deemed necessary 8 9 and appropriate and consistent with the provisions of this act the 10 Oklahoma Energy Education and Marketing Act to implement the provisions of this act and carry out the functions and duties of the 11 Commission on Marginally Producing Oil and Gas Wells with the 12 exception of making annual reports as required by paragraph 7 of 13 subsection A of Section 701 of Title 52 of the Oklahoma Statutes 14 15 this title.

E. Monies remaining in the Commission on Marginally Producing Oil and Gas Wells Revolving Fund created in Section 705 of Title 52 of the Oklahoma Statutes this title shall be transferred to the credit of the Sustaining Oklahoma's Energy Resources Revolving Fund created in Section 288.5B of Title 52 of the Oklahoma Statutes this title for use as provided in this act the Oklahoma Energy Education and Marketing Act.

F. The Committee for Sustaining Oklahoma's Energy Resources
 with the advice and consent of the Oklahoma Energy Resources Board

Legacy Oil and Gas Well Innovation Committee is authorized to
 promulgate any rules necessary to implement the provisions of this
 act the Oklahoma Energy Education and Marketing Act. The Secretary
 of Energy may provide assistance as necessary to oversee the
 transfer of duties, assets and obligations pursuant to this act the
 Oklahoma Energy Education and Marketing Act.

SECTION 3. AMENDATORY 52 O.S. 2011, Section 288.5B, as
last amended by Section 3, Chapter 199, O.S.L. 2013 (52 O.S. Supp.
2020, Section 288.5B), is amended to read as follows:

10 Section 288.5B. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a 11 revolving fund for the Committee for Sustaining Oklahoma's Energy 12 Resources Legacy Oil and Gas Well Innovation Committee to be designated the "Sustaining Oklahoma's Energy Resources Legacy Oil 13 and Gas Well Innovation Committee Revolving Fund". The fund shall 14 be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and 15 shall consist of all monies transferred to the Committee for 16 Sustaining Oklahoma's Energy Resources Legacy Oil and Gas Well 17 Innovation Committee to further the purposes of this act the 18 Oklahoma Energy and Marketing Act from any public appropriations and 19 donations, grants, contributions or gifts from any public or private 20 source. All monies including the existing balance of funds on the 21 effective date of this act accruing to the credit of the fund are 22 hereby appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the 23 Committee for Sustaining Oklahoma's Energy Resources Legacy Oil and 24

1	Gas Well Innovation Committee for the purpose of encouraging and
2	funding research and development of new technologies in the oil and
3	natural gas industry and funding activities to support marginally
4	producing oil and gas wells. Expenditures from the fund shall be
5	made upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer against claims
6	filed as prescribed by law with the Director of the Office of
7	Management and Enterprise Services for approval and payment.
8	SECTION 4. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
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
