COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to legislative ethics training;  
requiring certain amount of training for legislators;  
requiring enforcement by the President Pro Tempore of  
the Senate and the Speaker of the House of  
Representatives; providing for noncodification; and  
providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be  
codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

Every two years, each house of the legislature shall require two  
(2) hours total of mandatory training for its members emphasizing  
the rules of the Ethics Commission applicable to members of the  
legislature. The training information and presentation, monitoring  
and enforcement of this provision shall be determined by the  
President Pro Tempore of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of  
Representatives for their respective delegations. The members of  
the Senate shall report to the President Pro Tempore of the Senate.

1 The members of the House of Representatives shall report to the  
2 Speaker of the House of Representatives.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
