Projects completed 20 by the WPA improved the infrastructure and culture of those cities 21 for decades, allowing the United States to thrive after World War 22 II, and continue to stand the test of time today. completion of each project, a plaque was mounted in plain view to

let the public know the project was constructed for the people of that community. It is the intent of the Legislature to do the same, with all infrastructure or construction projects in this state that are funded partially or fully by the COVID-19 Recovery and Resilience Initiative as authorized and administered by Oklahoma's Joint Committee for Pandemic Relief Funding.
```

B. All infrastructure or construction projects in this state that are funded partially or fully by Oklahoma's Joint Committee for Pandemic Relief Funding shall have signage displayed in a prominently visible location at the project site. It is the intent of the Legislature that such signage reference the COVID-19 Recovery and Resilience Initiative, the Joint Committee for Pandemic Relief Funding, and the year completed. The Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department shall oversee the design and placement of any such signage on each project.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
