8 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Science and
9 Technology Research and Development Board; amending
10 74 O.S. 2011, Section 5060.6, which relates to board
of directors; modifying membership of board;
appointing chair; establishing length of term;
specifying quorum; and providing an effective date.

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13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2011, Section 5060.6, is
15 amended to read as follows:

16 Section 5060.6. A. The board of directors for ~~the Oklahoma~~
17 ~~Center for the Advancement of Science and Technology (OCAST) is~~
18 ~~hereby reconstituted as the Oklahoma Science and Technology Research~~
19 ~~(OSTRaD) and Development (OSTRaD) Board shall consist of ten (10)~~
20 members and shall be comprised as follows:

21 1. ~~The Director of the Oklahoma Department of Commerce Five~~
22 members appointed by the Governor, with the advice and consent of
23 the Senate;

1 2. The Chancellor of the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher
2 Education One member appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the
3 Senate;

4 3. The president of the University of Oklahoma One member
5 appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives;

6 4. The One member appointed by the president of Oklahoma State
7 University;

8 5. The president of one of the regional universities in The
9 State System of Higher Education designated by the Chancellor One
10 member appointed by the president of the University of Oklahoma; and

11 6. The president of a private Oklahoma university classified by
12 the Carnegie Foundation as a national doctorate-granting institution
13 offering graduate engineering degrees to be appointed by the
14 Governor;

15 7. The Governor's appointed cabinet Secretary of Agriculture;

16 8. A member of the House of Representatives, who shall serve as
17 an ex officio nonvoting member, appointed by the Speaker of the
18 House of Representatives;

19 9. A member of the Senate, who shall serve as an ex officio
20 nonvoting member, appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the
21 Senate;

22 10. Two members, appointed by the Governor, who shall be
23 engineers or scientists with extensive experience in managing basic
24 or applied scientific or technological research at Oklahoma

1 institutions of higher education, who shall serve terms of four (4)
2 years; provided that, the two members who possess these
3 qualifications and are serving on the board of directors of the
4 Center on July 1, 2002, shall fill these positions on the Oklahoma
5 Science and Technology Research and Development Board for initial
6 terms to expire on June 30, 2003;

7 11. Five members appointed by the Governor who are or who have
8 served as chief executive officers or senior executive officers of
9 corporations engaged in information technology, biotechnology,
10 genetics, other emerging technologies, agriculture, oil and natural
11 gas, early stage high risk venture capital finance, other
12 significant Oklahoma industries, or Oklahoma industries that are
13 potentially significant to the state economy or who are or who have
14 served as chief executive officers or senior executive officers of a
15 private nonprofit organization or who are or who have served as
16 chief executive officers or senior executive officers of foundations
17 with a history of supporting research and development. Two members
18 appointed pursuant to this paragraph shall serve initial terms to
19 expire on June 30, 2005, and two shall serve initial terms to expire
20 on June 30, 2006. For the position for which the initial
21 appointment begins after July 1, 2005, the initial term shall expire
22 on June 30, 2009;

23 12. Four members appointed by the Governor who represent small
24 business. One appointee shall serve an initial term to expire on

1 June 30, 2005, and one shall serve an initial term to expire on June
2 30, 2006. For the two positions for which the initial appointments
3 begin after July 1, 2005, one appointee shall serve an initial term
4 to expire on June 30, 2008, and one appointee shall serve an initial
5 term to expire on June 30, 2009;

6 13. One member appointed by the Governor who represents rural
7 Oklahoma. The initial appointee shall serve a term to expire on
8 June 30, 2004; and

9 14. Until June 30, 2004, or vacation of the offices, six
10 members who, before the effective date of this act, were appointed
11 by the Governor and who are serving on the board of directors of
12 OCAST on July 1, 2002. These positions on the Oklahoma Science and
13 Technology Research and Development Board shall cease to exist on
14 June 30, 2004, or when the position is vacated if the vacancy occurs
15 prior to June 30, 2004. A member of the OCAST board who holds one
16 of these positions may be appointed to a position described in
17 paragraphs 9 through 12 of this subsection on the Oklahoma Science
18 and Technology Research and Development Board if the member meets
19 the qualifications for such position.

20 B. The two legislatively appointed members of the Board shall
21 be persons of demonstrated knowledge of and commitment to the
22 advancement of science and technology in Oklahoma and shall serve at
23 the pleasure of their respective appointing authority The Secretary
24 of Science and Innovation.

1 B. The Secretary of Science and Innovation shall serve as
2 chair.

3 C. In making appointments to the Oklahoma Science and
4 Technology Research and Development Board, appropriate consideration
5 shall be given to representation upon the Board by race, gender and
6 geographical area.

7 D. ~~Gubernatorial appointees appointed after July 1, 2002, shall~~
8 ~~serve four-year terms except for initial terms as provided in this~~
9 ~~section. Terms shall expire on June 30. All gubernatorial~~
10 ~~appointees shall be subject to confirmation by the Senate. Except~~
11 ~~as otherwise provided in this section, any vacancy in board~~
12 ~~positions filled by appointment of the Governor shall be filled for~~
13 ~~the unexpired term in the same manner as the original appointment~~
14 With the exception of the Secretary of Science and Innovation, all
15 members shall be appointed for a term of (4) years.

16 E. ~~The Board shall elect, annually, a chair who shall be from~~
17 ~~the private sector membership of the Board. A vice-chair shall be~~
18 ~~elected annually from among all the members of the Board. Persons~~
19 ~~elected to the position of chair or vice-chair shall not serve more~~
20 ~~than two consecutive terms in said position.~~

21 F. The Board shall meet at least once each calendar quarter and
22 at such other times:

- 23 1. Upon call of the chair;

1 2. Upon call of the chief executive officer of the Center or
2 the Institute; or

3 3. Upon written request of a majority of the board members.

4 E. F. A majority of the six (6) voting members of the Board
5 shall constitute a quorum. A quorum of the Board shall be necessary
6 to transact business. All actions of the board members shall be
7 made by a majority of the quorum present. ~~A board member appointed~~
~~pursuant to paragraphs 3, 4, 5 or 6 of subsection A of this section~~
~~may send a predetermined designee as a representative to board~~
~~meetings who may participate with full voting privileges. All other~~
~~board members may send a predetermined designee as a representative~~
~~to board meetings who may vote; provided, the designee may vote at~~
~~no more than thirty percent (30%) of meetings during a fiscal year.~~

14 H. G. Members of the Board shall be entitled to compensation
15 and expenses as may be provided in the charter or bylaws of the
16 Board. The members of the Board shall not be subject to the dual-
17 office-holding prohibitions set forth in Section 6 of Title 51 of
18 the Oklahoma Statutes.

19 I. The Board shall establish an executive committee composed of
20 the chair, vice-chair, and three (3) additional voting members
21 chosen by the chair from among the remaining board members. The
22 executive committee, in intervals between board meetings, may
23 transact any board business that has been delegated to the executive
24 committee. A majority of the executive committee shall be necessary

1 | ~~to transact business and all actions of the executive committee~~
2 | ~~shall be by a majority vote of the committee.~~

3 | SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
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
