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14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
15	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 19 O.S. 2011, Section 321, as
16	amended by Section 1, Chapter 190, O.S.L. 2012 (19 O.S. Supp. 2020,
17	Section 321), is amended to read as follows:
18	Section 321. A. Each county shall be divided by the board of
19	county commissioners into three (3) compact districts, as equal in
20	population as practicable and numbered respectively one, two $_{m{ au}}$ and
21	three. One commissioner shall be elected from each of said the
22	districts by the voters of the district, as provided for by law.
23	B. 1. Each county shall be reapportioned by the board of
24	county commissioners on or before October 1 following the final

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1 official publication of the Federal Decennial Census to the State of 2 Oklahoma this state for the purposes of legislative redistricting. 3 Provided, for purposes of the 2021 reapportionment of counties, each 4 county shall be reapportioned by the board of county commissioners 5 on or before November 30, 2021, following the final official publication of the Federal Decennial Census to this state for the 6 purposes of legislative redistricting. The reapportionment shall be 7 recorded in a resolution adopted by the commissioners. 9 resolution shall include an effective date for the reapportioned 10 county commissioner districts. The effective date shall be January 11 1 of the following year.

2. Beginning with the reapportionment following the 1990
Federal Decennial Census, all boundaries of county commissioner
districts shall follow clearly visible, definable and observable
physical boundaries which are based upon criteria established and
recognized by the Bureau of the Census of the United States
Department of Commerce for purposes of defining census blocks for
its decennial census.

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3. If the commissioners fail to reapportion the county as
required by this subsection, the commissioners shall be subject to
the provisions of Sections 91 through 105 of Title 51 of the
Oklahoma Statutes and it shall be the duty of the county excise
board to perform the reapportionment.

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C. There is hereby established a depository for county commissioner district boundary maps and reapportionment resolutions within the Office of Geographic Information within the Oklahoma Conservation Commission. SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval. 58-1-1900 2/23/2021 3:33:29 PM CAP

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
