17	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
18	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 160.23 of Title 17, unless there
19	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
20	A. Beginning January 1, 2022, there shall be a fee of One
21	Dollar (\$1.00) per kilowatt of total nameplate generating capacity
22	for commercial wind energy equipment, as defined pursuant to Section
23	160.13 of Title 17 of the Oklahoma Statutes. The fee shall be paid

to the Corporation Commission on January 1 of each year by the owner of the commercial wind energy equipment.

- B. All fees not paid on January 1 shall be considered delinquent and the Corporation Commission shall assess a penalty to be paid by owners of commercial wind energy equipment of one percent (1%) of the total amount due on the last day of each month until the fee is paid.
- C. All fee revenues and penalty interest collected by the Corporation Commission pursuant to subsections A and B of this section shall be deposited in the Education Reform Revolving Fund of the State Department of Education.
- 12 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
