18	be employed or operate as a security guard, private investigator,
19	security agency, or investigative agency until a license therefor
20	has been issued by the Council on Law Enforcement Education and
21	Training pursuant to the Oklahoma Security Guard and Private
22	Investigator Act.
23	B. On or after November 1, 2022, a person employed or operating
2.4	as an unarmed security quard who has submitted a complete license
