COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to public retirement systems;
providing that certain active classroom teachers
receive three years of service for certain school
year; and providing for codification.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 17-116.24 of Title 70, unless
there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Any active classroom teacher, as defined in Section 17-101 of
Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes, employed by a public school
district during the 2020-2021 school year who was physically present
on school property for classroom instruction for at least one
hundred thirty (130) days and continues to be employed as an active
classroom teacher for the 2021-2022, 2022-2023 and 2023-2024 school
years shall receive three (3) years of creditable service for the
2020-2021 school year for purposes of reaching normal retirement
age.
