

CONFERENCE COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An act relating to medical marijuana; creating the Oklahoma Flower and Pre-Packaging Act; directing licensed medical marijuana processors and licensed medical marijuana commercial growers to sell certain medical marijuana products in pre-packaged form; providing requirements for packaging; allowing for the display and smelling of marijuana; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 431 of Title 63, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Oklahoma Flower and Pre-Packaging Act".

1       SECTION 2.       NEW LAW       A new section of law to be codified  
2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 431.1 of Title 63, unless there  
3 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

4       A. Upon the effective date of this act, all medical marijuana  
5 flower, trim, shake, kief, medical marijuana product, or other  
6 flower-based product not defined as a concentrate, shall be sold by  
7 licensed medical marijuana processors and licensed medical marijuana  
8 commercial growers to licensed medical marijuana dispensaries only  
9 in pre-packaged form in package sizes weighing not less than one-  
10 half (1/2) of one (1) gram to not more than three (3) ounces.

11       B. Nonopaque materials may be used when packaging medical  
12 marijuana flower provided all other packaging and labeling  
13 requirements for medical marijuana products sold in the State of  
14 Oklahoma are met and it is placed in an opaque container before  
15 leaving a licensed medical marijuana dispensary.

16       C. The display and smelling of medical marijuana shall be  
17 allowed pursuant to current Oklahoma law.

18       SECTION 3. This act shall become effective January 1, 2023.
