15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
16	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
17	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5-17a of Title 2, unless there
18	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
19	A. The right of Oklahomans to engage in agritourism activities
20	is ingrained in the historical fabric of the State of Oklahoma.
21	Therefore, it is the intent of the Legislature to preserve such
22	activities for future generations of Oklahomans.
23	B. Except as otherwise provided in this subsection, the rights
24	of Oklahomans to engage in agritourism activities shall not be

banned by any county, municipality, state agency or political subdivision. Agritourism activities shall only be engaged in a lawful manner and in compliance with health and safety zoning requirements, as well as health and safety regulations, by the state and local governments.

C. "Agritourism activities" as used in this section means utilizing livestock or other animals for entertainment or
```

utilizing livestock or other animals for entertainment or educational purposes. This shall include horseback riding, horsedrawn carriage rides, livestock and other animal shows, petting zoos, rodeos, activities that historically involved the utilization of working animals and other substantially similar activities.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
