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14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
15	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2011, Section 94, as
16	amended by Section 794, Chapter 304, O.S.L. 2012 (74 O.S. Supp.
17	2020, Section 94), is amended to read as follows:
18	Section 94. A. Except as otherwise provided by law, the Office
19	of Management and Enterprise Services shall have full and complete
20	authority to designate quarters for every department of state
21	government, and to determine what space shall be allotted; provided
22	that no department of state government shall be designated quarters
23	or allotted space that results in the relocation of such
24	department's employees, or relocation of the performance of duties

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imposed upon such department by law, to a location beyond a radius of ten (10) miles from where such employees and performance of such duties were located as of March 1, 2021, unless such relocation is directly authorized by an act of the Legislature.

- B. The Office may lease adequate space in state buildings and facilities to private vendors for the location of automatic teller machines as determined necessary or appropriate by the Director of the Office. The Office is hereby authorized to fix the monthly amount to be paid by such vendors, which shall be deposited in the General Revenue Fund.
- SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3320 of Title 74, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

No agency, board, commission, authority, bureau, office or other department of state government shall relocate such entity's employees, or relocate the performance of duties imposed upon such entity by law, to a location beyond a radius of ten (10) miles from where such employees and performance of such duties were located as of March 1, 2021, unless such relocation is directly authorized by an act of the Legislature.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby

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declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
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    be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
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
