10	to use of professional designations; modifying definition of doctor to include certain persons; and
11	providing an effective date.

14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
15	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 59 O.S. 2011, Section 725.2, is
16	amended to read as follows:
17	Section 725.2 A. The following nine classes of persons may use
18	the word "Doctor", or an abbreviation thereof, and shall have the
19	right to use, whether or not in conjunction with the word "Doctor",
20	or any abbreviation thereof, the following designations:
21	1. The letters "D.P.M." or the words podiatrist, doctor of
22	podiatry, podiatric surgeon, or doctor of podiatric medicine by a
23	person licensed to practice podiatry under the Podiatric Medicine
24	Practice Act;

2. The letters "D.C." or the words chiropractor or doctor of
 chiropractic by a person licensed to practice chiropractic under the
 Oklahoma Chiropractic Practice Act;

3. The letters "D.D.S." or "D.M.D.", as appropriate, or the
words dentist, doctor of dental surgery, or doctor of dental
medicine, as appropriate, by a person licensed to practice dentistry
under the State Dental Act;

8 4. The letters "M.D." or the words surgeon, medical doctor, or 9 doctor of medicine by a person licensed to practice medicine and 10 surgery under the Oklahoma Allopathic Medical and Surgical Licensure 11 and Supervision Act;

12 5. The letters "O.D." or the words optometrist or doctor of 13 optometry by a person licensed to practice optometry under Sections 14 581 through 606 of this title;

15 6. The letters "D.O." or the words surgeon, osteopathic
16 surgeon, osteopath, doctor of osteopathy, or doctor of osteopathic
17 medicine by a person licensed to practice osteopathy under the
18 Oklahoma Osteopathic Medicine Act;

19 7. The letters "Ph.D.", "Ed.D.", or "Psy.D." or the words 20 psychologist, therapist, or counselor by a person licensed as a 21 health service psychologist pursuant to the Psychologists Licensing 22 Act;

8. The letters "Ph.D.", "Ed.D.", or other letters representing
a doctoral degree or the words language pathologist, speech

pathologist, or speech and language pathologist by a person licensed as a speech and language pathologist pursuant to the Speech-Language Pathology and Audiology Licensing Act and who has earned a doctoral degree from a regionally accredited institution of higher learning in the field of speech and language pathology; and

9. The letters "Ph.D.", "Ed.D.", or other letters representing
a doctoral degree or the word audiologist by a person licensed as an
audiologist pursuant to the Speech-Language Pathology and Audiology
Licensing Act and who has earned a doctoral degree from a regionally
accredited institution of higher learning in the field of audiology.

11 Unless otherwise specifically provided in a particular Β. 12 section or chapter of the Oklahoma Statutes, the word "doctor" or 13 "doctors" shall mean and include each of the nine classes of persons 14 listed in subsection A of this section and the word "physician" or 15 "physicians", as provided in subsection C of this section. Anv 16 other person using the term doctor, or any abbreviation thereof, 17 shall designate the authority under which the title is used or the 18 college or honorary degree that gives rise to use of the title.

C. Unless otherwise specifically provided in a particular section or chapter of the Oklahoma Statutes, the word "physician" or "physicians" shall mean and include each of the classes of persons listed in paragraphs 1 through 6 <u>and psychologists in paragraph 7</u> of subsection A <u>of this section</u> and the word "doctor" or "doctors" as provided in subsection B of this section. The term "physician"

1 shall not include any person specified in paragraphs 7 through 9
2 with the exception of psychologists in paragraph 7 of subsection A
3 of this section unless such person is otherwise authorized to use
4 such designation pursuant to this section.

D. For purposes of this section, "provider" means and includes:
1. Each of the nine classes of persons listed in subsection A
of this section and referred to in subsections B and C of this
section; and

9 2. Any other person using the term doctor or any abbreviation10 thereof.

E. Persons in each of the nine classes listed in subsection A, 11 12 and referred to in subsections B and C, of this section shall 13 identify through written notice, which may include the wearing of a 14 name tag, the type of license under which the doctor is practicing, 15 utilizing the designations provided in subsections A, B and C of 16 this section. Each applicable licensing board is authorized by rule 17 to determine how its license holders may comply with this disclosure 18 requirement.

19 F. 1. Any advertisement for health care services naming a 20 provider shall:

21a.identify the type of license of the doctor utilizing22the letters or words set forth in this section if the23person is one of the classes of persons listed in

1 subsection A of this section, and referred to in 2 subsections B and C of this section, or 3 b. utilize appropriate, accepted, and easily understood 4 words or letters, which clearly show and indicate the 5 branch of the healing art in which the person is licensed to practice and is engaged in, if the person 6 7 is not one of the nine classes of persons listed in subsection A of this section, or referred to in 8 9 subsections B and C of this section.

10 2. The term "advertisement" includes any printed document 11 including letterhead, video clip, or audio clip created by, for, or 12 at the direction of the provider or providers and advertised for the 13 purpose of promoting the services of the doctor or provider.

14 G. It shall be unlawful for any medical doctor, doctor of 1. 15 osteopathic medicine, doctor of dental surgery, doctor of dental 16 medicine, doctor of optometry, doctor of podiatry, doctor of 17 psychology or doctor of chiropractic to make any deceptive or 18 misleading statement, or engage in any deceptive or misleading act, 19 that deceives or misleads the public or a prospective or current 20 patient, regarding the training and the license under which the 21 person is authorized to practice.

22 2. The term "deceptive or misleading statement or act"23 includes, but is not limited to:

a. such statement or act in any advertising medium,

1 b. making a false statement regarding the education, 2 skills, training, or licensure of a person, or 3 in any other way describing the profession, skills, с. 4 training, expertise, education, or licensure of a 5 person in a fashion that causes the public, a potential patient, or current patient to believe that 6 7 the person is a medical doctor, doctor of osteopathic medicine, doctor of dental surgery, doctor of dental 8 9 medicine, doctor of optometry, doctor of podiatry, 10 doctor of psychology or doctor of chiropractic when 11 that person does not hold such credentials. 12 Η. Notwithstanding any other provision of this section, a 13 person licensed in this state to perform speech pathology or 14 audiology services is designated to be a practitioner of the healing

art for purposes of making a referral for speech pathology or 16 audiology services pursuant to the provisions of the Individuals 17 with Disabilities Education Act, Amendment of 1997, Public Law 105-18 17, and Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
