13	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
14	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 14-109.4 of Title 47, unless
16	there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
17	A. A motor vehicle or a commercial motor vehicle, if operated
18	by an engine fueled wholly or partially by an electric battery or
19	hydrogen fuel cell electric fueling system, may exceed the gross
20	vehicle weight limits and any axle weight limits by an amount, not
21	to exceed a maximum of two thousand (2,000) pounds, that is equal to
22	the difference between:

The weight of the vehicle attributable to electric batteries
 or hydrogen fuel cell electric fueling system carried by that
 vehicle; and

2. The weight of a comparable diesel tank and fueling system.
B. The weight exemption allowed under this section shall extend
to all state roads and highways; however, vehicles operating
pursuant to the provisions of this section shall only be allowed to
operate on the National System of Interstate and Defense Highways
with a federal exemption.

10 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation 11 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby 12 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and 13 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
