NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 19 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-111 of Title 11, unless there 20 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 2.1 In addition to any other requirement of law for a city or town 22 to publish a notice in a newspaper, the city or town shall make the 23 same information as required to be contained in the newspaper 24 publication available on a website maintained by or on behalf of the

city or town for a period of time equal to the periods of time during which the information is required to be contained in a newspaper publication beginning with the first publication date and ending with the last publication date. A city or town may allow the information to be available on the website for a longer period of time and shall maintain records of the information on the website for a period of one (1) year from the latest date as of which the information was required to be displayed on the website. No power interruption or hardware or software failure related to the website or the website information shall be a basis to invalidate the action or proceeding the notice of which is required to be displayed on the website. No power interruption or hardware or software failure with respect to the computer system, cellular phone, tablet, or any other portable device used to access the information on the municipal website by any person or legal entity shall be the basis to invalidate the action or proceeding notice of which is required to be displayed on the municipal website.

SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-112 of Title 11, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

With respect to any publication requirement imposed by law for a city or town, if the publication requirement involves a daily newspaper and the newspaper is published for fewer than five (5) days in the time period prior to the action or proceeding for which

1	the publication is required, the newspaper may satisfy the
2	requirement of publication for the prescribed period by a
3	combination of hard copy publication and display of the same
4	information as contained in the hard copy publication on a website
5	maintained by or on behalf of the newspaper. No power interruption
6	or hardware or software failure related to the website or the
7	website information shall be a basis to invalidate the action or
8	proceeding the notice of which is required to be displayed on the
9	website.
10	SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
