SUBCOMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION

An Act relating to motor license agents; amending 47 O.S. 2021, Section 1132A, which relates to registration renewals; modifying certain inclusion; modifying allowance fee retention; providing an effective date; declaring an emergency; and providing for certain contingent effect.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2021, Section 1132A, is amended to read as follows:

Section 1132A. A. In any online system which provides a service that a motor license agent is authorized to provide pursuant to the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act there shall include a step where the individual shall select a motor license agent in the state to process any online transaction.

Said motor license agent as defined in Section 1102 of this title does not include the Oklahoma Tax Commission. ~~Any motor license agent fees collected by a state agency shall be deposited into the General Revenue Fund.~~

1 B. Upon the effective date of this act through May 31, 2023,

2 Motor license agents selected as provided in subsection A of this
3 section shall receive all fees provided by the Oklahoma Vehicle
4 License and Registration Act; ~~provided, the amount of fees remitted~~
5 ~~to the motor license agent for each online transaction processed by~~
6 ~~the motor license agent through any online system shall be reduced~~
7 ~~by One Dollar and fifty-six cents (\$1.56).~~

8 C. The selection step required pursuant to subsection A of this
9 section shall be installed and operational no later than January 1,
10 2021.

11 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2022.

12 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
13 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
14 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
15 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

16 SECTION 4. The provisions of this act shall be contingent upon
17 the enactment of the provisions of House Bill No. 3419 or Senate
18 Bill No. 1605 of the 2nd Session of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature
19 and shall not become operative as law otherwise.
