Section 2-146. A. There is hereby created in the State 1 2 Treasury a revolving fund for the Department of Public Safety, to be designated the "Department of Public Safety Patrol Academy Revolving 3 Fund". The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal 4 5 year limitations. All monies accruing to the credit of said fund are hereby appropriated and shall be budgeted and expended by the 6 7 Department of Public Safety for the exclusive purpose of Oklahoma Highway Patrol Trooper Academies. Expenditures from said fund shall 8 9 be made upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer against claims 10 filed as prescribed by law with the Director of the Office of 11 Management and Enterprise Services for approval and payment. 12 B. On or before December 1 of each year, the Department of 13 Public Safety shall provide a written report on all Oklahoma Highway 14 Patrol Trooper Academies conducted in the then current and preceding 15 state fiscal year to the Speaker of the Oklahoma House of 16 Representatives, the President Pro Tempore of the State Senate, the 17 Chair of the Appropriations and Budget Committee of the Oklahoma 18 House of Representatives, and the Chair of the Appropriations 19 Committee of the State Senate. Such report shall include, but not 20 be limited to, the following information for the then current and 21 preceding state fiscal year: 22 1.
