16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
17	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 64 O.S. 2011, Section 1005, is
18	amended to read as follows:
19	Section 1005. A. The Land Office shall be administered by the
20	Secretary of the Land Office under the supervision of the
21	Commissioners of the Land Office. The Secretary shall, subject to
22	the qualifications listed in subsection B of this section, be
23	appointed by the Governor with the advice and consent of the
24	Oklahoma State Senate and the Commissioners of the Land Office. The

1 Secretary may be removed from office by a simple majority vote of the members elected to and constituting the Oklahoma House of 3 Representatives. It shall be the duty of the Secretary to execute, under the supervision of the Commissioners of the Land Office, the 5 provisions of the Enabling Act of Oklahoma as it relates to the management of school lands and other public lands, the Constitution 6 7 of the State of Oklahoma, and all laws, regulations, and duties pertaining to the Commissioners of the Land Office and to carry into 8 9 execution the will of the Commissioners of the Land Office not in 10 conflict with any law.

B. The Secretary of the Land Office shall:

- 1. Possess an advanced degree from an accredited college or university;
 - 2. Have not less than five (5) years of experience in government, law or finance; and
 - 3. Meet other specific requirements as specified by the Commissioners of the Land Office.
 - c. The Secretary of the Land Office shall serve a four-year term of service concurrent with the term of the appointing Governor and the other elected officials on the Commission. The Secretary may serve consecutive terms and may serve past the term of the appointing Governor only until a successor is appointed. If the appointment is terminated or if the Secretary resigns, becomes incapacitated or for any reason is unable to perform the duties of
