10	An Act relating to the Oklahoma Conservation Commission; amending 82 O.S. 2021, Section 1501-
11	205.1, which relates to the State Geographic Information Council; allowing certain appointments to
12	serve successive terms; providing certain exception for partial terms; allowing the Governor to appoint
13	members without recommendation by the Council; clarifying statutory language; and providing an
14	effective date.
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17	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
18	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 82 O.S. 2021, Section 1501-205.1,
19	is amended to read as follows:
20	Section 1501-205.1. A. As used in this section and in Sections
21	1501-205.2 and 1501-205.3 of this title:
22	1. "Geographic information" means any data or databases in
23	which location or spatial distribution is an essential element $_{m au}$
24	including, but not limited to, land, air, water, and mineral

1 resources, the distribution of plant, animal, and human populations, 2 real property interests, zoning and other land development 3 regulations, and political, jurisdictional, ownership, and other 4 artificial divisions of geography;

2. "Geographic Information System" or "GIS" means computer
systems that allow the analysis of data or databases containing
geographic information; and

8 3. "Statewide data" means geographic information whose spatial
9 extent is defined by the geographic boundary of the state of
10 Oklahoma this state.

B. There is hereby created a State Geographic Information
Council composed of nineteen (19) members as follows:

Director of the Oklahoma Conservation Commission or
 designee;

15 2. Director of the Department of Environmental Quality or 16 designee;

17 3. Chair of the Corporation Commission or designee;

18 4. Director of the Oklahoma Department of Commerce or designee;

19 5. Commissioner of the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture,

20 Food, and Forestry or designee;

21 6. Director of the Oklahoma Water Resources Board or designee;

22 7. Director of the Department of Transportation or designee;

23 8. State Geographer or designee;

Director of the Oklahoma Geological Survey or designee;

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Director of the Center for Spatial Analysis of the
 University of Oklahoma or designee;
 11. Dean of the Division of Agricultural Sciences and Natural

4 Resources of Oklahoma State University or designee;

5 12. Director of the Ad Valorem Division of the Oklahoma Tax6 Commission or designee;

7 13. A member appointed by the Director of the <u>Oklahoma</u>
8 Conservation Commission from a list of names submitted to the
9 Director from the Oklahoma regional universities;

10 14. Director of Information Services of the Office of
11 Management and Enterprise Services or designee;

12 15. Director of <u>State</u> Wildlife Conservation <u>Director</u> or 13 designee;

14 16. Director of Homeland Security or designee; and

15 17. Three members to be appointed by the Governor pursuant to 16 subsection C of this section.

С. The Governor shall appoint three members to the Council to 17 serve initial terms as specified by this subsection. Thereafter, 18 the terms of all appointed members shall be four (4) years. 19 Gubernatorial members shall not be appointed to more than three 20 successive terms. Members that are appointed by the Governor to 21 fill a vacancy may serve three successive terms. No appointment to 22 a partial term to fill a vacancy shall be counted for purposes of 23 determining term limits. Incumbent members may continue to serve on 24

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1 the Council until a new appointment is made. Upon recommendation by 2 the Council, the <u>The</u> following members shall be appointed by the 3 Governor:

A representative of the Oklahoma Association of Regional
 Councils, appointed for an initial four-year term;

6 2. A representative of county assessors, appointed for an7 initial three-year term; and

8 3. A representative of city government, appointed for an
9 initial two-year term.

D. The chair of the Council shall be the Director of the Oklahoma Conservation Commission or designee. Meetings shall be called by the chair.

E. 1. A majority of the membership of the Council constitutesa quorum for the conduct of business.

15 2. The Council shall meet at least twice each year, and the 16 chair may call a meeting of the Council as often as necessary to 17 transact business.

18 F. A member of the Council shall not:

Be an officer, employee, or paid consultant of a business
 entity that has, or an officer, employee, or paid consultant of a
 trade association for business entities that have, a substantial
 interest in the geographic information industry and are doing
 business with state agencies or other governmental units of the
 state;

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2. Own, control, or have directly or indirectly, more than ten
 percent (10%) interest in a business entity that has a substantial
 interest in the geographic information industry and is doing
 business with state agencies or other governmental units of the
 state;

Be an officer, employee, or paid consultant of a business
entity that is connected with any contract or bid for furnishing to
any governmental body of the state with Geographic Information
Systems, the computers on which they are automated, or a service
related to Geographic Information Systems;

4. Be a person required to register as a lobbyist because of
 activities for compensation on behalf of a business entity that has,
 or on behalf of a trade association of business entities that have,
 a substantial interest in the geographic information industry; or

15 5. Accept or receive money or another thing of value from an
16 individual, firm, or corporation to whom a contract may be awarded,
17 directly or indirectly, by rebate, gift or otherwise.

18 G. The duties of the Council shall include overseeing the19 Office of Geographic Information concerning the following:

Development, adoption, and recommendation of standards and
 procedures that may be applied to geographic information and
 Geographic Information Systems to promote consistency of data
 elements;

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Development of a strategy for the implementation and funding
 of a statewide Geographic Information System;

3	3. Development, delivery, and periodic revision of a statewide
4	geographic information plan and annually reporting to the Governor
5	and the Legislature. Such a plan shall include, but not be limited
6	to, provisions for training and education; and
7	4. Promotion of collaboration and sharing of data and data
8	development as well as other aspects of Geographic Information
9	Systems.
10	H. Neither the Council nor its members shall have the power to
11	form or award contracts or to employ staff. Members appointed by
12	the Governor shall serve without compensation.
13	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
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
