8 An Act relating to students; amending 70 O.S. 2021,
9 Section 27-103, which relates to the Oklahoma
10 Extracurricular Activities Accountability Act;
11 requiring certain association's written policy to
12 include certain provision regarding participation of
13 certain students; repealing 70 O.S. 2021, Section 8-
14 103.2, which relates to a prohibition on
15 participating in certain competitions for certain
16 time period following transfer; providing an
17 effective date; and declaring an emergency.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 70 O.S. 2021, Section 27-103, is
20 amended to read as follows:

21 Section 27-103. A public school or school district shall not be
22 a member of any school athletic association unless that association
23 has adopted a written policy that requires the following:

24 1. All records of the association to be made accessible
consistent with the provisions of the Oklahoma Open Records Act;

2. All meetings of the association to be open and conducted in
a manner consistent with the provisions of the Oklahoma Open Meeting

1 Act, including specifically the notice and agenda, voting and
2 executive session requirements; ~~and~~

3 3. An annual financial audit and a compliance audit of all
4 funds of the association in accordance with the auditing standards
5 set forth in the Oklahoma Public School Audit Law. In addition, the
6 association shall have performance audits conducted of the
7 operations of the association. A performance audit shall be
8 conducted no later than December 31, 2014, and by December 31 every
9 five (5) years thereafter; and

10 4. A student who enrolls in a school district in which the
11 student is not a resident pursuant to the Education Open Transfer
12 Act is allowed to participate in interscholastic activities or
13 contests offered by the receiving school district upon enrollment.

14 SECTION 2. REPEALER 70 O.S. 2021, Section 8-103.2, is
15 hereby repealed.

16 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 2022.

17 SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
18 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
19 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
20 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
