3. No person shall operate a Class C commercial motor vehicle
unless the person is eighteen (18) years of age or older and holds a
valid Class C commercial license, except as provided in subsection F
of this section. Any person holding a valid Class C commercial
license shall be permitted to operate motor vehicles in Classes C
and D, except as provided for in paragraph 4 of this subsection.

No person under twenty-one (21) years of age shall be
 licensed to operate any motor vehicle which is required to be
 placarded for hazardous materials pursuant to 49 C.F.R., Part 172,
 subpart F, except as provided in subsection F of this section;
 provided, a person eighteen (18) years of age or older may be
 licensed to operate a farm vehicle which is required to be placarded

for hazardous materials pursuant to 49 C.F.R., Part 172, subpart F,
 except as provided in subsection F of this section.

5. A person at least seventeen (17) years of age who successfully completes all examinations required by law may be issued by the Department:

a. a restricted Class A commercial license which shall
grant to the licensee the privilege to operate a Class
A or Class B commercial motor vehicle for harvest
purposes or a Class D motor vehicle, or

b. a restricted Class B commercial license which shall
grant to the licensee the privilege to operate a Class
B commercial motor vehicle for harvest purposes or a
Class D motor vehicle.

14 6. No person shall operate a Class D motor vehicle unless the
15 person is sixteen (16) years of age or older and holds a valid Class
16 D license, except as provided for in Section 6-102 or 6-105 of this
17 title. Any person holding a valid Class D license shall be
18 permitted to operate motor vehicles in Class D only.

C. Any person issued a driver license pursuant to this section may exercise the privilege thereby granted upon all streets and highways in this state.

D. No person shall operate a motorcycle or motor-driven cycle without having a valid Class A, B, C or D license with a motorcycle endorsement. Except as otherwise provided by law, any new applicant

1 for an original driver license shall be required to successfully complete a written examination, vision examination and driving 2 examination for a motorcycle as prescribed by the Department of 3 Public Safety, and a certified state-approved motorcycle basic rider 4 5 course approved by the Department if the applicant is seventeen (17) years of age or younger to be eligible for a motorcycle endorsement 6 The written examination and driving examination for a 7 thereon. motorcycle shall be waived by the Department of Public Safety upon 8 9 verification that the person has successfully completed a certified Motorcycle Safety Foundation rider course approved by the 10 Department. 11

12 E. Except as otherwise provided by law, any person who lawfully possesses a valid Oklahoma driver license which is eligible for 13 renewal shall be required to successfully complete a written 14 examination, vision examination and driving examination for a 15 motorcycle as prescribed by the Department, and a certified state-16 approved motorcycle basic rider course approved by the Department if 17 the person is seventeen (17) years of age or younger to be eligible 18 for a motorcycle endorsement. The written examination and driving 19 examination for a motorcycle shall be waived by the Department of 20 Public Safety upon verification that the person has successfully 21 completed a certified Motorcycle Safety Foundation rider course 22 approved by the Department. 23

1 F. 1. Any person eighteen (18) years of age or older may apply for a restricted Class A, B or C commercial learner permit. 2 The Department, after the applicant has passed all parts of the 3 examination for a Class D license and has successfully passed all 4 5 parts of the examination for a Class A, B or C commercial license other than the driving examination, may issue to the applicant a 6 commercial learner permit which shall entitle the person having 7 immediate lawful possession of the commercial learner permit and a 8 9 valid Oklahoma driver license or provisional driver license pursuant to Section 6-212 of this title to operate a Class A, B or C 10 commercial motor vehicle upon the public highways solely for the 11 purpose of behind-the-wheel training in accordance with rules 12 13 promulgated by the Department.

This commercial learner permit shall be issued for a period 2. 14 as provided in Section 6-115 of this title of one hundred eighty 15 (180) days, which may be renewed one time for an additional one 16 hundred eighty (180) days; provided, such commercial learner permit 17 may be suspended, revoked, canceled, denied or disqualified at the 18 discretion of the Department for violation of the restrictions, for 19 failing to give the required or correct information on the 20 application or for violation of any traffic laws of this state 21 pertaining to the operation of a motor vehicle. Except as otherwise 22 provided, the lawful possessor of a commercial learner permit who 23 has been issued a commercial learner permit for a minimum of 24

fourteen (14) days may have the restriction requiring an accompanying driver removed by satisfactorily completing a driver's examination; provided, the removal of a restriction shall not authorize the operation of a Class A, B or C commercial motor vehicle if such operation is otherwise prohibited by law.

3. No person shall apply for and the Department shall not issue 6 an original Class A, B or C driver license until the person has been 7 issued a commercial learner permit and held the permit for at least 8 9 fourteen (14) days. Any person who currently holds a Class B or C license and who wishes to apply for another class of commercial 10 driver license shall be required to apply for a commercial learner 11 12 permit and to hold the permit for at least fourteen (14) days before applying for the Class A or B license, as applicable. Any person 13 who currently holds a Class A, B or C license and who wishes to add 14 an endorsement or remove a restriction for which a skills 15 examination is required shall be required to apply for a commercial 16 17 learner permit and to hold the permit for at least fourteen (14) days before applying for the endorsement. 18

A commercial learner permit shall be issued by the
 Department as a separate and unique document which shall be valid
 only in conjunction with a valid Oklahoma driver license or
 provisional driver license pursuant to Section 6-212 of this title,
 both of which shall be in the possession of the person to whom they

have been issued whenever that person is operating a commercial

5. After one renewal of a commercial learner permit, as provided in paragraph 2 of this subsection, a commercial permit shall not be renewed again. No person who has been honorably discharged from active 14 service in any branch of the Armed Forces of the United States or 15 Oklahoma National Guard and who has been certified by the United 16 17 States Department of Veterans Affairs, its successor or the Armed Forces of the United States to be a disabled veteran in receipt of 18 compensation at the one-hundred-percent rate for a permanent 19 disability sustained through military action or accident resulting 20 from disease contracted while in such active service and registered 21 with the veterans registry created by the Oklahoma Department of 22 Veterans Affairs shall be charged a fee for the issuance, 23 replacement or renewal of an Oklahoma driver license; provided, that 24

In accordance with the provisions of subsection G of this 4 Ο. 5 section, the Department of Public Safety and the Oklahoma Tax Commission are authorized to promulgate rules for the issuance and 6 renewal of driver licenses authorized pursuant to the provisions of 7 Sections 6-101 through 6-309 of this title; provided, that no such 8 9 rules applicable to the issuance or renewal of REAL ID Noncompliant Driver Licenses shall create more stringent standards than such 10 rules applicable as of January 1, 2017, unless directly related to a 11 specific change in statutory law concerning standards for REAL ID 12 13 Noncompliant Driver Licenses. Applications, upon forms approved by the Department of Public Safety, for such licenses shall be handled, 14 in accordance with the provisions of subsection G of this section, 15 by the motor license agents; provided, the Department of Public 16 Safety is authorized to assume these duties in any county of this 17 state. Each motor license agent accepting applications for driver 18 licenses shall receive Six Dollars (\$6.00) for a 4-year REAL ID 19 Noncompliant Driver License or Twelve Dollars (\$12.00) for an 8-year 20 REAL ID Noncompliant Driver License or Ten Dollars (\$10.00) for a 4-21 year REAL ID Compliant Driver License or Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for 22 an 8-year REAL ID Compliant Driver License to be deducted from the 23 total collected for each license or renewal application accepted. 24

1 Beginning July 1, 2022, and ending on May 31, 2023, each motor 2 license agent or licensed operator accepting applications for driver licenses for individuals over the age of sixty-five (65) years or 3 for applications for drivers pursuant to subsection P of this 4 5 section shall receive Six Dollars (\$6.00) for a 4-year driver license or Twelve Dollars (\$12.00) for an 8-year driver license to 6 be deducted daily by the motor license agent or licensed operator 7 receipts. The amount retained pursuant to this subsection shall not 8 9 be retained by any state agency. The fees received by the motor license agent, authorized by this subsection, shall be used for 10 11 operating expenses. For purposes of this subsection, "licensed 12 operator" shall mean an individual who obtains a license from the 13 Service Oklahoma Operator Board to operate a designated Service Oklahoma location and offers third-party fulfillment of designated 14 services to be rendered by Service Oklahoma. 15

R. Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 1104 of this title and subsection Q of this section and except as provided in subsections H and M of this section, the first Sixty Thousand Dollars (\$60,000.00) of all monies collected pursuant to this section shall be paid by the Oklahoma Tax Commission to the State Treasurer to be deposited in the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury.

23 The next Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00) of monies 24 collected pursuant to this section shall be paid by the Tax 1 Commission to the State Treasurer to be deposited each fiscal year under the provisions of this section to the credit of the Department 2 of Public Safety Restricted Revolving Fund for the purpose of the 3 Statewide Law Enforcement Communications System. All other monies 4 5 collected in excess of Five Hundred Sixty Thousand Dollars (\$560,000.00) each fiscal year shall be apportioned as provided in 6 Section 1104 of this title, except as otherwise provided in this 7 section. 8

9 S. The Department of Public Safety shall retain the images 10 displayed on licenses and identification cards issued pursuant to 11 the provisions of Sections 6-101 through 6-309 of this title which 12 may be used only:

By a law enforcement agency for purposes of criminal
 investigations, missing person investigations or any law enforcement
 purpose which is deemed necessary by the Commissioner of Public
 Safety;

By the driver licensing agency of another state for its
 official purpose; and

All agencies approved by the Oklahoma Law Enforcement Telecommunications System (OLETS) or the National Law Enforcement Telecommunications System (NLETS) to receive photographs or computerized images may obtain them through OLETS or through NLETS.

Photographs or computerized images may be obtained by law
 enforcement one inquiry at a time.

The computer system and related equipment acquired for this purpose must conform to industry standards for interoperability and open architecture. The Department of Public Safety may promulgate rules to implement the provisions of this subsection.

No person may hold more than one state-issued or territory-7 Τ. issued REAL ID Compliant Driver License or REAL ID Compliant 8 9 Identification Card from Oklahoma or any other state or territory. The Department shall not issue a REAL ID Compliant Driver License to 10 a person who has been previously issued a REAL ID Compliant Driver 11 License or REAL ID Compliant Identification Card until such license 12 13 or identification card has been surrendered to the Department by the applicant. The Department may promulgate rules related to the 14 issuance of replacement REAL ID Compliant Driver Licenses in the 15 event of loss or theft. 16

Upon the effective date of this act Beginning May 24, 2021, 17 U. and ending on April 30, 2023, in addition to the amounts provided in 18 subsection Q of this section, a motor license agent shall receive 19 Five Dollars (\$5.00) for each processed application for a REAL ID 20 Compliant 4-year Driver License and Ten Dollars (\$10.00) for each 21 processed application for a REAL ID Compliant 8-year Driver License. 22 Any additional amounts provided pursuant to this subsection shall 23 not be retained by the Department of Public Safety. 24
