8	An Act relating to roofing; amending 59 O.S. 2021, Section 1151.2, which relates to definitions; adding
9	definition; amending 59 O.S. 2021, Section 1151.9, which relates to applicability of the Roofing
10	Contractor Registration Act; providing exception for commercial endorsement for labor-only subcontractors;
11	updating statutory language; and providing an effective date.
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14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
15	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 59 O.S. 2021, Section 1151.2, is
16	amended to read as follows:
17	Section 1151.2. As used in the Roofing Contractor Registration
18	Act:
19	1. "Advertise" means any written publication, dissemination,
20	solicitation, contract, bid, promotional item, or circulation which
21	is intended to directly or indirectly induce any person to contract
22	for roofing construction services with the advertiser $_{m  au}$ including,
23	but not limited to, business cards, telephone directory display
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1 advertisements, vehicle signage, radio, television and electronic
2 solicitations;

3 2. "Applicant" means the qualifying party, or if no qualifying
4 party, any person applying under the Roofing Contractor Registration
5 Act for a roofing contractor registration to be issued by the
6 Construction Industries Board;

"Board" means the Construction Industries Board; 3. 7 "Commercial labor-only subcontractor" means a registered 8 4. 9 roofing subcontractor who works under the direct supervision of a commercial endorsed roofing contractor, is hired to perform only the 10 11 labor for installation of commercial roofing work where the total 12 contract value of the job does not exceed Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00) and does not provide any roofing material for 13 the work; 14

15 <u>5.</u> "Committee" means the Committee of Roofing Examiners; 16 <u>5.</u> <u>6.</u> "Homeowner" means one who owns and resides in, or who 17 resides in, or who contracts for the purchase, construction, 18 remodeling or repairing of a residence;

19 6. 7. "Nonresident contractor" means any contractor who has not 20 established and maintained a place of business as a roofing 21 contractor in this state within the preceding year, or who claims 22 residency in another state, or who has not submitted an income tax 23 return as a resident of this state within the preceding year;

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1 7. 8. "Owner" means person who owns the property or is a lessee
2 of the property;

3 8. 9. "Person" means any natural person, firm, limited or
4 general partnership, corporation, association, limited liability
5 company, trust, association, other legal entity and any organization
6 capable of conducting business, or any combination thereof acting as
7 a unit, unless the intent to give a more limited meaning is
8 disclosed clearly by the Roofing Contractor Registration Act;

9 9. 10. "Prime contractor" means a general contractor,
10 commercial contractor, or other contractor who contracts directly
11 with the owner for construction trade work in multiple trade areas;
12 10. 11. "Project manager" means one who manages construction
13 projects consisting of work involving multiple trades;

11. 12. "Public contract" means a contract with the State of 14 Oklahoma, its political subdivisions, or any board, commission, or 15 department thereof, or with any board of county commissioners, or 16 with any city council, school board, or with any state or municipal 17 agency, or with any other public board, body, commission, or agency 18 authorized to award contracts for the construction or reconstruction 19 of public works and includes subcontracts undertaken to perform 20 works covered by the original contract or any part thereof; 21

22 <u>12. 13.</u> "Qualifying party" means a natural person who is an 23 officer or owner of the corporation, a member of the limited 24 liability company, or a general partner of the limited liability

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partnership, and who is actively engaged in the work undertaken by the registrant for which a registration is required pursuant to the Roofing Contractor Registration Act who meets the experience and ability requirements for registration on behalf of the registrant; <u>13. 14.</u> "Registrar" means the Construction Industries Board or any person designated by the Board to administer the provisions of the Roofing Contractor Registration Act;

8 <u>14.</u> <u>15.</u> "Registration" means the process of applying for an 9 initial or renewal registration which upon approval is exhibited by 10 a registration number and card issued pursuant to the Roofing 11 Contractor Registration Act;

12 15. <u>16.</u> "Registration number" means the roofing registration 13 number issued by the registrar to the registrant's qualifying party; 14 <u>16. 17.</u> "Registrant" means a holder of a registration issued 15 pursuant to the Roofing Contractor Registration Act;

17. 18. "Residence" means a single structure for residential 16 occupancy or use which is a detached one- to four-family dwelling or 17 a multiple single-family dwelling (townhouse) not more than three 18 stories/floors above grade plane in height with a separate means of 19 egress, and any appurtenances thereto, which is intended for use as 20 a primary habitation and is in compliance with the International 21 Residential Code, as adopted by the Oklahoma Uniform Building Code 22 Commission; 23

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1 18. "Roofing contractor" means any person $_{\overline{r}}$  including a subcontractor and nonresident contractor, engaged in the business of 2 commercial or residential roofing contractor work, or who himself or 3 herself, or through another, attempts to or advertises, holds 4 5 himself or herself out as having, or purports to have, the capacity to undertake roofing contractor work, or offers to engage in or 6 solicits roofing installation-related services  $\overline{r}$  including 7 construction, installation, renovation, remodeling, reroofing, 8 9 repair, maintenance, alteration, and waterproofing, unless specifically exempted in the Roofing Contractor Registration Act. 10 Roofing contractor shall not mean: 11

a. a person engaged in the demolition of a structure or
 the cleanup of construction waste and debris that
 contains roofing material,

b. a person working under the direct supervision of the
roofing contractor who is hired either as an employee,
day laborer, or contract laborer whose payment,
received in any form, from the roofing contractor is
subject to self-employment tax,

## c. a person working on his or her own property or that of an immediate relative and such person is not receiving any compensation, or

d. a person acting as a handyman who is receiving
 compensation from the property owner and who is

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performing the roofing repair in conjunction with other repairs to the property and who does not perform more than two roofing jobs per year;

19. 20. "Roofing contractor work" means the installation, 4 5 fabrication or assembly of equipment or systems included in roofing systems as defined in the International Building Code and the 6 International Residential Code, as adopted by the Oklahoma Uniform 7 Building Code Commission, and which codes are hereby adopted and 8 9 incorporated by reference. Roofing construction work includes, but is not limited to, installation, renovation, remodeling, reroofing, 10 reconstructing, repair, maintenance, improvement, alteration, and 11 12 waterproofing, unless specifically exempted in the Roofing 13 Contractor Registration Act.

"Commercial roofing contractor work" means work done 14 a. on commercial, industrial or public building roofing 15 systems or structures as defined in the International 16 Building Code, as adopted by the Oklahoma Uniform 17 Building Code Commission; except it does not mean 18 buildings used for commercial purposes having 19 equivalent or substantially the same roofing 20 requirements as a "residence" defined herein $\tau$ 21 including but not limited to business offices 22 converted from a structure that formerly was a 23 residence, and 24

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1 b. "Residential roofing contractor work" means work done 2 on roofing systems as defined in the International Residential Code, as adopted by the Oklahoma Uniform 3 Building Code Commission, or as defined as a 4 5 "residence" herein; including buildings used for commercial purposes having asphalt shingles, tile 6 shingles, synthetic shakes, wood shakes or other 7 comparable materials applied to a sloped roof equal to 8 9 the same roofing requirements as a "residence" defined herein $_{\overline{r}}$  including but not limited to business offices 10 converted from a structure that formerly was a 11 12 residence;

13 20. <u>21.</u> "Roofing Hearing Board" means the Roofing Hearing Board 14 which shall consist of a designee of the Construction Industries 15 Board, as chair, and the members of the Committee of Roofing 16 Examiners;

17 <u>21. 22.</u> "Subcontractor" means one who contracts with a prime 18 contractor, general contractor, residential contractor, project 19 manager, property manager, another subcontractor, or another entity 20 for roofing contractor work;

21 <u>22. 23.</u> "Variance" means the use of an alternative material or 22 method of construction from that prescribed in the International 23 Building Code or the International Residential Code or other 24 approved documents by the Oklahoma Uniform Building Code Commission

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1 for use at a particular location or project specified in the 2 variance application;

3 23. 24. "Variance and Appeals Board" means the Oklahoma State
4 Roofing Installation Code Variance and Appeals Board;

5 24. 25. "Labor-only crews" means a crew that is to perform the 6 installation of asphalt shingles, tile shingles, synthetic shakes, 7 wood shakes or other comparable materials to a sloped roof and to 8 complete roofing work; and

9 25. 26. "Prefabricated- or pre-engineered-metal-building
10 erector" means the labor necessary to construct the components of a
11 prefabricated- or pre-engineered-metal-building package, known as
12 PEMB, as defined by the Construction Science Institute and
13 Construction Specifications Institute in Division 13, Special
14 Construction: Metal Building Systems.

15 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 59 O.S. 2021, Section 1151.9, is 16 amended to read as follows:

17 Section 1151.9. A. Any administrative or governing body with 18 authority to enter into public contracts shall require individual 19 roofing contractor registration for purposes of such persons 20 submitting or entering into any bid or contract involving roofing 21 contractor work.

B. The Roofing Contractor Registration Act does not apply to:
1. An actual owner of residential or farm property who
physically performs, or has a family member, employee or employees

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who perform with or without remuneration, roofing services including, construction, installation, renovation, repair, maintenance, alteration, waterproofing, or removal of materials or structures on property owned by such person;

2. Any authorized employee, representative or representatives
of the United States Government, the State of Oklahoma, or any
county, municipality, or other political subdivision of this state;

3. Any person who furnishes any fabricated or finished product,
material, or article of merchandise which is not incorporated into
or attached to real property by such person so as to become affixed
thereto;

12 4. Any person including churches or other charitable entities 13 that provide roof repairs or replacements at no charge using 14 volunteer labor;

15 5. Any employee of a registrant who does not hold himself or 16 herself out for hire, advertise, or engage in contracting, except as 17 an employee of a registrant;

18 6. Licensed engineers, licensed architects, licensed HVAC and
19 any other person licensed by the jurisdiction, operating under the
20 purview and within the scope of their respective license;

7. A person who only furnishes roofing materials, roofing
supplies or equipment and does not, nor do the person's employees,
install or fabricate them into or consume them in the performance of
the work of the roofing contractor;

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8. Prime contractors, general contractors, property managers and project managers who bid on construction trade work in areas additional to roofing contractor work, and subcontract the roofing contractor work as long as they subcontract the roofing work to a currently registered roofing contractor who is in good standing; if the bid is solely for roofing contractor work, then a registration is required;

9. Owners of commercial properties including residential rental 8 9 properties consisting of four dwelling units or less, when acting as their own roofing contractor and providing all material supervision 10 themselves, lessees of residential properties with the consent of 11 12 the owner, who, whether themselves or with their own employees, perform roofing construction in or upon the properties, all 13 installing roofing materials according to the International Building 14 Code, as adopted by the Oklahoma Uniform Building Code Commission, 15 or the manufacturer's installation instructions; 16

10. Owners of property when acting as their own roofing 17 contractor, providing all material supervision themselves, and 18 installing roofing materials according to the International 19 Residential Code, as adopted by the Oklahoma Uniform Building Code 20 Commission, or the manufacturer's installation instructions when 21 building or improving a single-family dwelling residence on such 22 property for the occupancy of such owners and not intended for sale 23 or rent. In any action brought under the Roofing Contractor 24

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Registration Act, proof of the sale or offering for sale of such structure or the renting or offering to rent of such structure by the owners of the property within one (1) year after substantial completion of the structure when the structure can be occupied and used as intended but punch list items may remain, is presumptive evidence that the construction was undertaken with the intent of sale or rent; or

8 11. Metal building erectors who install prefabricated- or pre-9 engineered-metal-building packages, known as PEMBs, as defined by 10 the Construction Science Institute and Construction Specifications 11 Institute in Division 13, Special Construction: Metal Building 12 Systems.

C. <u>1.</u> Labor-only crews performing the installation of asphalt shingles, tile shingles, synthetic shakes or wood shakes to a sloped roof must be registered but are not required to have a commercial endorsement.

17 <u>2. A commercial labor-only subcontractor shall be registered</u> 18 <u>but is not required to have a commercial endorsement if the</u> 19 <u>commercial endorsed roofing contractor providing direct supervision</u> 20 <u>assumes full responsibility over the actions and performance of the</u> 21 <u>commercial labor-only subcontractor; provided, that the commercial</u> 22 <u>labor-only subcontractor is prohibited from bidding or contracting</u> 23 <u>commercial roofing work directly with a building owner or other</u>

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1	building management entity and the total contract value of the job	2
2	does not exceed Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00).	
3	SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.	
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
