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17	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
18	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 1, Chapter 141, O.S.L.
19	2020 (70 O.S. Supp. 2020, Section 27-104), is amended to read as
20	follows:
21	Section 27-104. A. This act shall be known and may be cited as
22	the "Riley Boatwright Act" "Riley's Rule".
23	B. Prior to the beginning of the <del>2020-2021</del> <u>2021-2022</u> school
24	year, each school district board of education shall coordinate with

the emergency medical services provider providers that serves serve 1 the area in which the school district is located to develop a plan 2 3 an Emergency Action Plan for the provision of emergency medical services at each facility and athletic practices, events or 4 5 activities held at school district facilities. C. The plan developed pursuant to subsection B of this sect 6 7 Emergency Action Plan shall: 1. Include maps and directions with appropriate contact 8 9 information for emergency medical services; 10 2. Assign a medical administrator who is a current school 11 employee such as a coach, administrator or athletic director; 12 3. Define responsibilities and personnel on-site, both medical and school officials; 13 4. Include a list of medical equipment available and location 14 15 of the nearest automated external defibrillator, if available; 16 5. Be posted in each facility; 6. Be distributed to all school officials involved in athletic 17 practices, events or activities held at school district facilities; 18 19 and 20 7. Specify documentation actions after any emergency to evaluate for debriefing purposes and to determine if there are 21 necessary changes to the Emergency Action Plan. 22 D. The Emergency Action Plan shall be reviewed and, updated and 23 rehearsed annually as appropriate, prior to the start of season 24

4	E. Prior to each athletic event or activity where there are
5	athletes participating from visiting schools, the Emergency Action
6	Plan shall be digitally transmitted to the visiting school
