Q 10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA: 11 A new section of law to be codified 12 SECTION 1. NEW LAW in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 508 of Title 69, unless there is 13 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 14 The Department of Transportation shall have the authority to 15 make additions to the state highway system without a corresponding 16 17 removal of mileage in the following circumstances: 18 1. The addition of highway miles will improve public safety; 19 There are local, private or other non-state resources contributed toward the capital costs of the addition; 20 3. Prior to the addition of highway miles, the performance 21 metrics of the regional highway system, developed pursuant to

Section 45.3 of Title 62 of the Oklahoma Statutes, are determined by

the Department of Transportation to be adequate in the strategic 1 2 qoal areas of: 3 achieving and sustaining less than one percent (1%) structurally deficient bridges, 5 b. increasing the percentage of highway lane miles in good condition, 6 decreasing the miles of rural two-lane roads with 7 C. deficient shoulders, as defined in Section 241 of 8 9 Title 69 of the Oklahoma Statutes, and 10 decreasing traffic fatalities; d. 11 The addition of highway miles can be shown to have a positive local or regional economic impact; 12 The Department determines that the resources required for 13 14 long term operation and maintenance exist; and The addition of highway miles is determined to be for the 15 16 benefit of the general public. 17 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021. 18 19 20 21 22 23 24
