7 An Act relating to the Department of Public Safety;
8 authorizing certain expenditures for certain
9 purposes; authorizing the Department of Public Safety
10 to hold additional trooper academies subject to
11 available funding; authorizing use of certain
12 revolving fund; providing lapse dates; and requiring
13 and prohibiting certain budget procedures.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. From the funds appropriated to the Department of
16 Public Safety in Enrolled House Bill No. 2900 of the 1st Session of
17 the 58th Oklahoma Legislature, the Department of Public Safety is
18 hereby authorized to expend Four Hundred Thirty-nine Thousand One
19 Hundred Twenty Dollars (\$439,120.00) for any necessary expenditures
20 related to interoperable communications inside the State Capitol
21 Building.

22 SECTION 2. From the funds appropriated to the Department of
23 Public Safety in Enrolled House Bill No. 2900 of the 1st Session of
24 the 58th Oklahoma Legislature, the Department of Public Safety is
hereby authorized to expend Four Million Dollars (\$4,000,000.00) to

1 hold a trooper academy. Subject to available funding, the
2 Department is authorized to hold additional academies.

3 SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the
4 Department of Public Safety is hereby authorized to utilize the
5 Department of Public Safety Restricted Revolving Fund (245 Fund), as
6 may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Department
7 of Public Safety by law.

8 SECTION 4. Appropriations made by this act, not including
9 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for
10 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2022 (hereafter FY-22), or may be
11 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2023 (hereafter FY-23).
12 Funds budgeted for FY-22 may be encumbered only through June 30,
13 2022, and must be expended by November 15, 2022. Any funds
14 remaining after November 15, 2022, and not budgeted for FY-23, shall
15 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal
16 year. Funds budgeted for FY-23 may be encumbered only through June
17 30, 2023. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2023, shall lapse
18 to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.
19 These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years
20 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-22, and not required to pay
21 obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-23, after
22 the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared
23 and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds
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1 from the FY-22 budget work program and after such revision has been
2 approved by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services.
