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7	An Act relating to the Department of Public Safety; authorizing certain expenditures for certain
8	purposes; authorizing the Department of Public Safety to hold additional trooper academies subject to
9	available funding; authorizing use of certain revolving fund; providing lapse dates; and requiring
10	and prohibiting certain budget procedures.
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13	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
14	SECTION 1. From the funds appropriated to the Department of
15	Public Safety in Enrolled House Bill No. 2900 of the 1st Session of
16	the 58th Oklahoma Legislature, the Department of Public Safety is
17	hereby authorized to expend Four Hundred Thirty-nine Thousand One
18	Hundred Twenty Dollars (\$439,120.00) for any necessary expenditures
19	related to interoperable communications inside the State Capitol
20	Building.
21	SECTION 2. From the funds appropriated to the Department of
22	Public Safety in Enrolled House Bill No. 2900 of the 1st Session of
23	the 58th Oklahoma Legislature, the Department of Public Safety is
24	hereby authorized to expend Four Million Dollars (\$4,000,000.00) to

hold a trooper academy. Subject to available funding, the
Department is authorized to hold additional academies.

3 SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the 4 Department of Public Safety is hereby authorized to utilize the 5 Department of Public Safety Restricted Revolving Fund (245 Fund), as 6 may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Department 7 of Public Safety by law.

SECTION 4. Appropriations made by this act, not including 8 9 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2022 (hereafter FY-22), or may be 10 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2023 (hereafter FY-23). 11 12 Funds budgeted for FY-22 may be encumbered only through June 30, 13 2022, and must be expended by November 15, 2022. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2022, and not budgeted for FY-23, shall 14 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal 15 year. Funds budgeted for FY-23 may be encumbered only through June 16 30, 2023. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2023, shall lapse 17 to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year. 18 These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years 19 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-22, and not required to pay 20 obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-23, after 21 the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared 22 and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds 23
