6 7	An Act relating to Department of Human Services;
8	requiring that portions of certain appropriated funds be used for certain purposes and priorities;
9	prioritizing expenditures of potential increases in federal funding; directing certain transfer; stating
10	purpose; appropriating certain federal monies; stating purpose; authorizing early transfers of certain funds for specific purposes; directing
11	certain transfer of appropriated funds in requested amounts and ratios; requiring maintenance of certain
12	records; providing for lapse of funds under certain conditions; requiring certain budget procedures; and
13 14	prohibiting certain budget procedures.
14	
16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
17	SECTION 1. From the funds appropriated to the Department of
18	Human Services in Enrolled House Bill No. 2900 of the 1st Session of
19	the 58th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of Two Million Dollars
20	(\$2,000,000.00) shall be used for providing services for persons
21	with developmental disabilities. These funds shall be used to
22	provide additional services and programs for persons with
23	developmental disabilities in order to reduce the size of the
24	Developmental Disabilities Services Division Waiting List based on

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need and shall be used to supplement rather than replace existing
resources and programs.

3 SECTION 2. The Department of Human Services shall contract with 4 a third party to obtain a standardized assessment of individuals on 5 the Developmental Disabilities Services Division Waiting List. This 6 assessment shall document the overall needs of the individuals and 7 be used for future funding requests.

8 SECTION 3. From the funds appropriated to the Department of 9 Human Services in Enrolled House Bill No. 2900 of the 1st Session of 10 the 58th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of Two Hundred Fifty Thousand 11 Dollars (\$250,000.00) shall be used to implement the provisions of 12 Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1044 of the 1st Session of the 58th 13 Oklahoma Legislature.

SECTION 4. From the funds appropriated to the Department of Human Services in Enrolled House Bill No. 2900 of the 1st Session of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of One Million Four Thousand Three Hundred Forty-four Dollars (\$1,004,344.00) shall be used to fund debt service obligations for the renovation and construction of the Robert M. Greer Center located in Enid, Oklahoma.

20 SECTION 5. In a manner not inconsistent with the provisions of 21 this act, any increase in federal funding related to an increase in 22 the Federal Medical Assistance Percentage (FMAP) match rate that is 23 not related to the COVID-19 pandemic shall be expended by the 24 Department of Human Services with priority given to the Medicaid

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waivered services to aging and developmentally disabled clients, the
Child Care Subsidy program, and the Adoption Subsidy program.

SECTION 6. From the funds appropriated to the Department of 3 Human Services in Enrolled House Bill No. 2900 of the 1st Session of 4 5 the 58th Oklahoma Legislature, the Department of Human Services shall transfer Two Million Eight Hundred Thousand Dollars 6 (\$2,800,000.00) to the credit of the Child Abuse Multidisciplinary 7 Account established in Section 1-9-103 of Title 10A of the Oklahoma 8 9 Statutes, which shall be distributed according to Section 1-9-104 of Title 10A of the Oklahoma Statutes. 10

SECTION 7. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of Human Services all federal monies received by the state during the fiscal year ending June 30, 2022, from the Temporary Assistance to Needy Families Block Grant and the Child Care and Development Fund Block Grant to meet the provisions of federal law relating to such grants.

SECTION 8. The Director of the Department of Human Services may request through the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services the early transfer by the Oklahoma Tax Commission of tax collections to the General Revenue Fund for the purpose of early allocation to the Department's disbursing funds to alleviate cash-flow problems.

23 SECTION 9. A. The Director of the Office of Management and 24 Enterprise Services shall transfer monies appropriated from the

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General Revenue Fund to the Department of Human Services' disbursing funds in the amounts and ratios requested by the agency except that the cumulative amount transferred shall not exceed the cumulative amount of equal monthly allotments of the appropriations from the General Revenue Fund.

B. Monies appropriated or collected for the fiscal year ending 6 7 June 30, 2022, may be transferred to these disbursing funds for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2021, to satisfy encumbrances and 8 9 obligations of the fiscal year; provided, that monies equal in 10 amount are transferred from appropriations or collections for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2021, to the disbursing funds for the 11 fiscal year ending June 30, 2022, to satisfy encumbrances and 12 obligations of the fiscal year. All transfer requests shall be in 13 writing to the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise 14 Services. 15

16 C. The Department of Human Services shall maintain records of 17 such intergear transfers.

SECTION 10. Appropriations made by Enrolled House Bill No. 2900 of the 1st Session of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature, not including appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2022 (hereafter FY-22), or may be budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2023 (hereafter FY-23). Funds budgeted for FY-22 may be encumbered only through June 30, 2022, and must be expended by November 15, 2022. Any funds

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1	remaining after November 15, 2022, and not budgeted for FY-23, shall
2	lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal
3	year. Funds budgeted for FY-23 may be encumbered only through June
4	30, 2023. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2023, shall lapse
5	to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.
6	These appropriations shall not be budgeted in both fiscal years
7	simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-22, and not required to pay
8	obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-23, after
9	the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared
10	and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds
11	from the FY-22 budget work program and after such revision has been
12	approved by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services.
